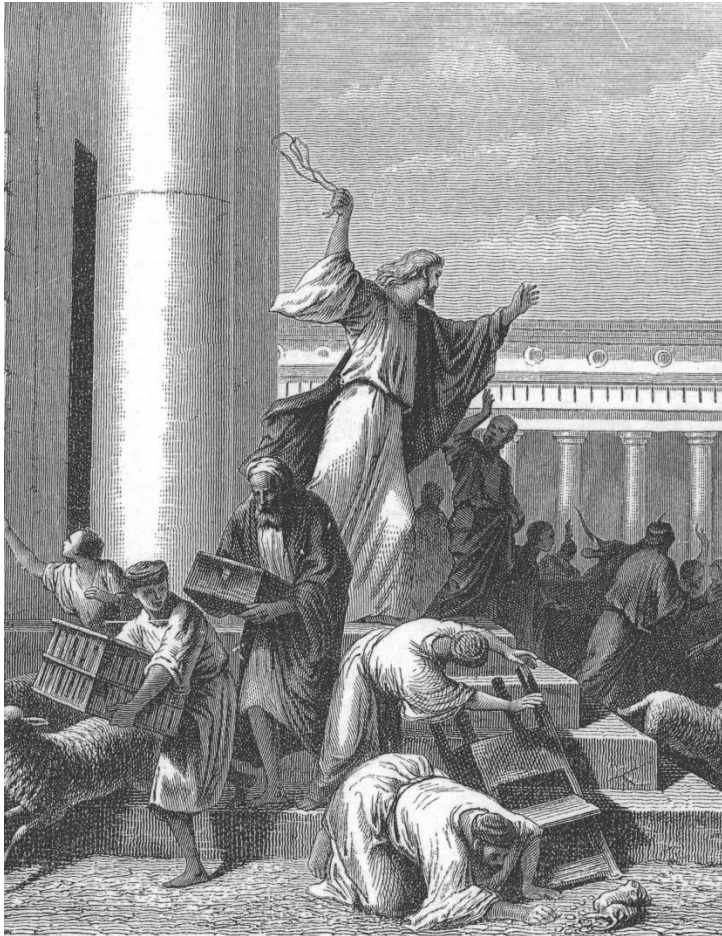

ENGLISH PATRIMONY EVENING PRAYER AND FELLOWSHIP

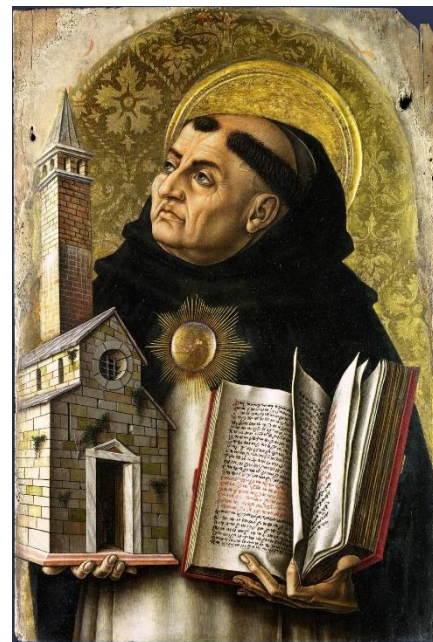

THE FEAST OF SAINT THOMAS AQUINAS

will be celebrated with a Solemn High Mass on Wednesday, March 7, at 7:00 PM. Cantores in Ecclesia will sing William Byrd’s *Mass for Four Voices* and the Gregorian Chant Proper. We hope that many of our parishioners will be free to attend this special Mass in honor of this great Dominican saint.

SAINT THOMAS AQUINAS was canonized by Pope John XXIII in 1323, was

declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope St. Pius V in 1567, and was named patron of all universities, colleges and schools in 1880 by Pope Leo XIII. Aquinas was probably the greatest theological master of Christianity, and his thought dominated Catholic teaching for seven centuries after his death. His *magnum opus*, the unfinished *Summa Theologiae*, is undoubtedly the greatest exposition of theological thought ever written and became the accepted basis for modern Catholic theology. In St. Thomas Aquinas the Middle Ages reached its full flowering and Christianity received its most towering and influential intellect. **IN THIS HOLY SEASON OF LENT**, when the liturgy recalls the public ministry of Jesus, let us ask St. Thomas so to penetrate us with the spirit of penance that we may have a clear vision of the teachings of the Master and put them into practice, as he did.
