DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Though there are a great number of people who honor Christ in His Divine Mercy on the Sunday after Easter, there remains confusion and debate about whether or not there is an indulgence attached to the devotions undertaken on the Feast Day. The opportunity for an indulgence as stated in the Diary of St. Maria Faustina is slightly confusing. The Holy See clarifies what particular acts should be done in addition to those found in the Diary. In the Decree of June 29, 2002 the Apostolic Penitentiary clearly states the required acts necessary for the indulgence: "...a plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!); A partial indulgence, granted to the faithful who, at least with a contrite heart, pray to the merciful Lord Jesus a legitimately approved invocation."
