REGARDING HOLY COMMUNION IN THE PYX FOR THE SICK In 2014 Holy Rosary ceased the practice of the distribution of Holy Communion for the sick at the altar rail. This was done in an effort to make certain that all the sick and homebound of the parish were receiving proper sacramental care. While we had recently loosened up a bit, the Archbishop has mandated that effective the Feast of Corpus Christi this practice is to cease across the Archdiocese of Portland. We will return to the former practice at this parish, effective immediately. For those of you who have been taking Holy Communion to the sick, please prepare your pyx in the sacristy before Mass. Ensure that the celebrant or sacristan is aware of the Communion call. When this is not possible, please approach one of the priests or the sacristan after Mass. The Archbishop has also mandated that the commissioning of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will be done in local parishes the weekend of Corpus Christi. For Holy Rosary, this would mostly entail those who take Communion to the sick. We can also send a representative group to the Cathedral, where Archbishop Sample will commission them at the Mass. Please provide the office with your name and the Mass you most often attend so we know to have you commissioned. Also, if you are currently visiting the elderly or the sick, please provide us with their name and contact information.
