### BLESSED WATER FOR THE SICK IN HONOR OF ST. VINCENT FERRER

On April 5, 2019 St. Vincent Ferrer died of illness in Vannes (Brittany, France) where he was on a trip preaching. St. Vincent was a Spanish Dominican friar who traveled through Western Europe preaching with great zeal. His preaching was known for its use of profound images and metaphors, though his great themes were conversion and the Last Judgment. It is said that although he spoke in Valencian from Galicia to Britain, people from all over Europe miraculously understood him. Many great miracles were performed during his life through his intercession.

Some provinces of the Order of Preachers and some dioceses around the world have convoked a Jubilee Year from April 2018 to May 2019. It is hoped it be a time of personal, ecclesial and pastoral conversion, an opportunity to intensify the preaching of the Gospel and focus our lives on the Lord Jesus Christ, and an opportunity for all the people of God to better know the figure of St. Vincent Ferrer.

At Holy Rosary Parish we will honor St. Vincent Ferrer with a special sacramental blessed in his honor. In the Order of Preachers, the tradition arose of blessing water in the name of St. Vincent Ferrer, as an invocation of assistance against illness. This is due, at least in part, to the reputation of this great saint as the instrument of many miraculous healings. This special sacramental, blessed by one of the friars with a first class relic of St. Vincent Ferrer, will be available in our parish office during this Jubilee Year.

**REGARDING HOLY COMMUNION IN THE PYX FOR THE SICK** In 2014 Holy Rosary ceased the practice of the distribution of Holy Communion for the sick at the altar rail. This was done in an effort to make certain that all the sick and homebound of the parish were receiving proper sacramental care. While we had recently loosened up a bit, the Archbishop has mandated that effective the Feast of Corpus Christi this practice is to cease across the Archdiocese of Portland. We will return to the former practice at this parish, effective immediately. For those of you who have been taking Holy Communion to the sick, please prepare your pyx in the sacristy before Mass. Ensure that the celebrant or sacristan is aware of the Communion call. When this is not possible, please approach one of the priests or the sacristan after Mass. The Archbishop has also mandated that the commissioning of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will be done in local parishes the weekend of Corpus Christi. For Holy Rosary, this would mostly entail those who take Communion to the sick. We can also send a representative group to the Cathedral, where Archbishop Sample will commission them at the Mass. Please provide the office with your name and the Mass you most often attend so we know to have you commissioned. Also, if you are currently visiting the elderly or the sick, please provide us with their name and contact information.
