

OUR LADY OF LOURDES GROTTO UPDATE

During this time that the city of Portland celebrates its annual Rose Festival, we can never forget the Rose in our midst: Our Lady the Mother of God and Queen of the Most Holy Rosary. This then is a perfect time for an update on our Lady of Lourdes Grotto on the north side of our church. Two large beautiful bronze statues of Our Lady and of St. Bernadette are currently at the foundry, though there is still much more detail work to be done. In the coming months, you will observe some minor changes to the landscaping at the grotto to beautify the area. We will also be working to restore the water that once flowed down into a pond at the base of the Grotto. It is our tentative plan to unveil the newly restored grotto as part of the celebrations in honor of the 125th anniversary of Holy Rosary Parish in January 2019. I want to make a special statement of thanks for all of our generous benefactors who are making this project possible. There are certainly still opportunities to provide for this wonderful outdoor shrine. To protect the grotto we will construct a functional, but tasteful black wrought iron fence. We are looking into the possibility of opening the gates during the daytime, but closing them during the nighttime for the protection of the sacred images. It is the hope of the Dominican Friars that restoring Our Lady to her proper place will serve as a beacon of hope for all who see her and seek her motherly protection.

ICONOGRAPHY WORKSHOP & RETREAT

July 29 - August 3 with Abbot Damian at Holy Theophany Monastery

He has given retreats and taught icon workshops throughout the United States, Canada, and Ukraine. Working primarily in egg tempera, his iconography is found in numerous churches, institutions, and private collections. Father Damian has served as the abbot of Holy Transfiguration Monastery, Redwood Valley, California since June of 2013 when he was elected abbot by the Monks of Mount Tabor, and was given the abbatial blessing and installed as Holy Transfiguration's third abbot by the Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Bishop of Chicago.
