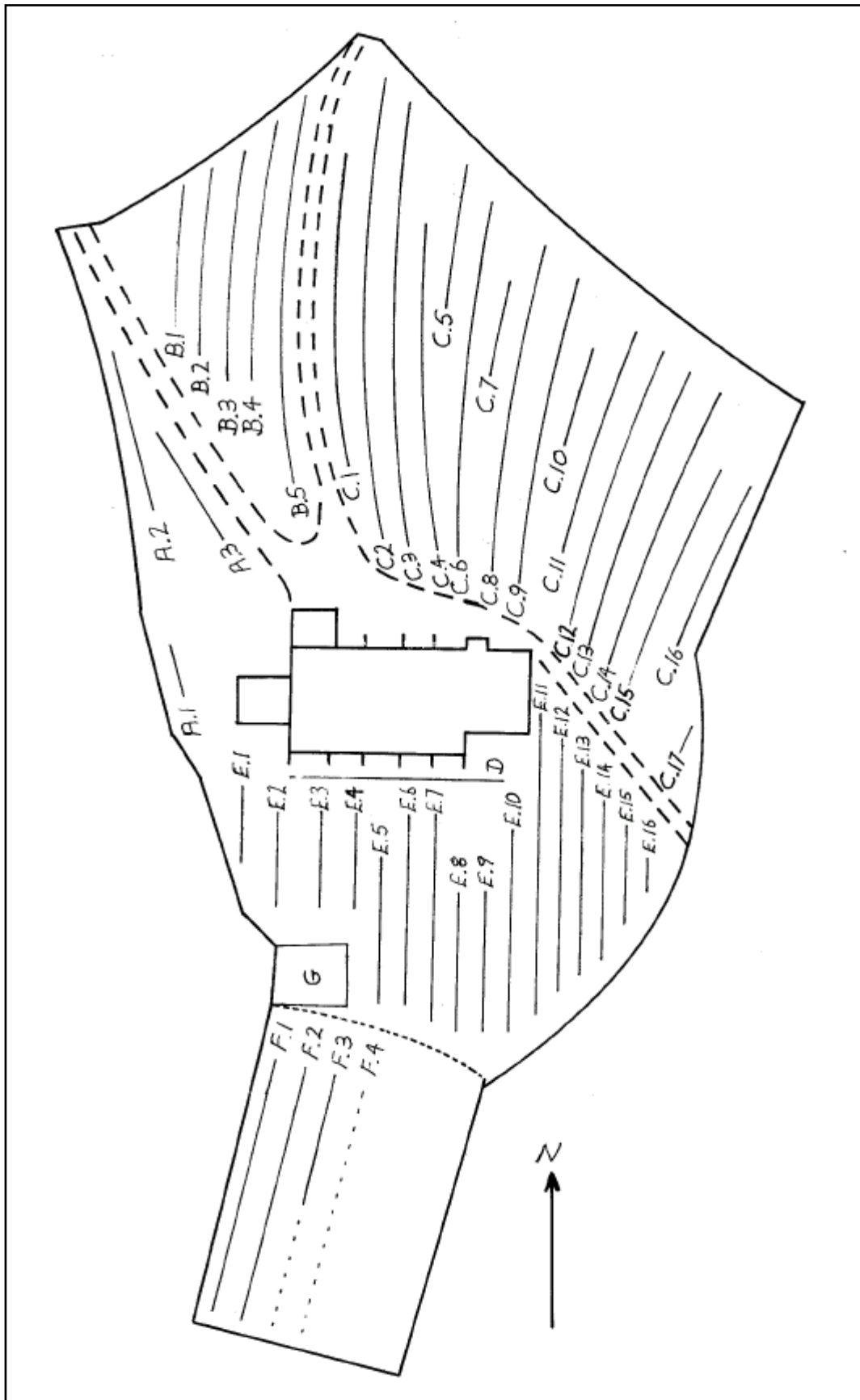

THE STAINED GLASS WINDOWS OF ST MARTIN'S CHURCH

The Carden Memorial Window (SW.7)

The Benediction of the Carden Memorial Window took place during a memorial service at 7.00 p.m. on Wednesday 18 July 1917. The service was conducted by the Rector, the Rev H Chilton Tomkins, who described the window thus:

“A Knight arrayed in mail of steel, over which is thrown a mantle of rich azure colour fastened on the shoulder with a jewelled brooch, is seen walking out of a stream - the river of death (Somme). The head is bare and the features depicted are those of Major Ronald Carden; the head is thrown back, looking up to his Lord who stands just above with the crown of life held forward ready to place it on the head of the approaching Knight, who is seen with both hands extended surrendering his sword - representing his life's work - to his Lord. A kneeling Angel proffers the palm branch of victory. The background shows trees (Mametz Wood) darkly outlined against the ruby and golden glow of the rising sun. At the top of the picture three Angels support a scroll bearing the words “Glory, Honour, Immortality - Rom 11-7”. At the bottom left hand corner are the armorial bearings of the family with the motto “Fide et Amore” and at the right hand corner the crest of the 17th Lancers, a skull and crossed bones with the motto “Or Glory”, this giving the regiment's popular title “The death or glory boys”. Between these is the inscription:

*To the Glory of God and in proud and loving memory of Ronald James Walter Carden,
Major 17th Lancers, killed in action in the Battle of the Somme when gallantly leading his
Battalion (16th Royal Welsh Fusiliers) in the assault on Marmetz Wood, 10th July 1916. This
window is dedicated by his brother and sister.*

The window was designed and executed by Messrs Daniels and Fricker, Fulham Road, and the building in by Mr Waite, North End.”

A separate description is provided on a printed statement beneath the window:

“The subject of the above window has been extremely well thought out. It is allegorical, that is, a description of one thing in the image of another. So it describes to us in a very beautiful picture how Ronald Carden gave up his life in the service of his King and Country on July 10th, 1916, and won for himself those three honours shewn in the scroll held by the angels in the upper part of the window. The Glory of a true soldier, the Honour of a brave Englishman and the Immortality of a faithful servant of God. Then, as to the picture, we see him represented as a knight stepping from the River Somme, the river of death, and offering his sword, the emblem of his life's work to his Lord, who is crowning him with the crown of life, whilst the angel kneeling below offers to him the palm branch of Victory. Above, there are the trees of Mametz Wood, in the attack on which he fell when gallantly leading his men of the 16th Battalion Royal Welsh Fusiliers, and through the trees can be seen the golden and red beams of the sun at dawn, at which time the attack took place. May this beautiful memorial be to us all a reminder of him who was a noble example in his life and death of a faithful soldier and servant of Jeus Christ.

O true, brave heart, God bless thee

The coats of arms in the corners are, on the right that of the 17th Lancers, Lieut-Colonel Ronald Carden's own Regiment 'The Death or Glory Boys' bearing the death's head and crossed lances with the colours of the Regiment; that on the left, the coat of Arms of the Carden family, with the family motto 'Fide et Amore' by faith and love. The field is pale sable and gules, bearing a staff sling in bend, between four pheons saltir-wise argent. A pheon is a barbed iron head of an arrow, or dart, or lance, derived from the old French foine, an eel spear, and from the latin fuscina, a trident.

The Window was dedicated to the Glory of God and in memory of Ronald Carden on Wednesday evening, July 18th 1917."

The Guillemard Memorial Window (East Window)

The East Window of St Martin's Church, in memory of Walter Guillemard and his daughter Phyllis Guillemard, was dedicated on 27th July 1919. Walter Guillemard, formerly a Master of Harrow School, lived at Malverlys. The window is described thus on a printed statement held by EWLHS:

"The three centre lights give the key to the complete design - the heart of the Christian Faith in the Incarnation of God, and the Beauty of Service, in Mercy and Love. The Star of the Epiphany hangs above the centre light, flanked by two angels, who gaze in reverent wonder on the Divine Mystery of God Incarnate.

The lights on either side set forth the Adoration of the Christ Child by the visible and invisible worlds, that is: by Humanity, the Shepherds; by the Heavenly Hosts, an angel carrying a lantern, proclaiming Christ the Light of the World. The remaining outer lights typify the Works of Mercy and Love as part of the Beauty of Christian Service.

On the left is St Christopher, giving his giant strength to the Christ Child. In the background is St Catherine's Hill, Winchester, and, above, the tower of Winchester College, of which foundation Walter Guillemard was a scholar.

The outer light on the right depicts Mercy and Love to sick and wounded mankind, for which Phyllis Guillemard gave her life as a V.A.D. in the Great War. She was born on the feast of St Michael and All Angels, hence the figure of the Archangel Michael. His sword is sheathed, and on his vesture is displayed the Red Cross. Above is the harbour and the towers of St Andrews where Phyllis Guillemard was educated at St Leonard's School. Her beloved retriever was broken hearted after her death, and is seen with the shepherds.

The pictures in the lower sections of the window, and some others, are full of personal touches, embodying the whole conception of the Beauty of Service.

The window was designed by Louis Davis."

The Sandbach Memorial Window ((NW.6)

The Sandbach Memorial Window was installed in 1949. No further information has yet been located.

The St Martin's Guild Window (NW.13)

A description is provided on a printed statement beneath the window:

“The Window above is the Memorial which St Martin's Guild have erected to commemorate for ever the names of those from this Parish who gave their lives for us in the Great War, 1914-1919. The picture in the window gives us the story of St Martin, the Soldier Patron Saint of our Church, that is the Saint in whose name the Church was dedicated to God.

The story is that on a cold winter's day a young soldier named Martin, in the Roman Army, rode forth from the gates of Amiens, and as he passed along the great Roman road he saw a poor old man shivering by the roadside. Martin immediately drew his sword, divided his cloak, and gave half to the beggar. That night he had a dream and saw our Lord wearing the half of his cloak which he had so charitably given away.

‘Know ye, said our Lord, who hath clothed me with this cloak? My servant Martin, though baptised, hath given me this. Well done my good and faithful servant.’

Directly after this vision Martin was baptised, and in 371 AD became Bishop of Tours. He died at the age of 81 more renowned, beloved and esteemed than any Saint after the apostolic age.

His name has been honoured throughout Christendom, and especially in France and England. 160 Churches are dedicated to God's glory in his name in England alone.”

This Memorial Window was dedicated on July 31st, 1921.
