- **Goal 1: Capacity.** Ensure funding for mitigation programs to increase capacity and reduce impacts from future natural hazards.
- **Goal 2: Education.** Raise awareness and expand knowledge of natural hazards, vulnerable areas, community assets, and resources that will catalyze action.
- **Goal 3: Resources.** Build strong social networks that expand access to community support systems and create a safety net for vulnerable populations subject to acute shocks and long-term stresses.
- **Goal 4: Economy.** Increase the capacity for business continuity to bounce back from shocks and thrive in the face of long-term stresses.
- **Goal 5: Effectiveness.** Foster systems and processes that allow for communities to expedite actions to build resiliency.
- **Goal 6: Engagement.** Expand stakeholders to include military, emergency responders, decision makers and diverse age groups.
- **Goal 7: Coordination.** Design a sustainable communication network across all sectors, industries, agencies, government and individuals that strengthens emergency protocols, promotes information sharing and decreases response time.
- **Goal 8: Stewardship.** Create a county-wide stewardship program that promotes long-term resiliency of ecosystems.
- **Goal 9: Infrastructure.** Ensure redundancies in critical infrastructure systems (roads, water, etc.) and monitor disturbances and risk.

**Question #1:** *What does resiliency mean for your sector? What does this look like? Allow 15 minutes*

A resilient community is one in which individual community members have the information and tools necessary to make resilient decisions, while an underlying culture of responsible governance drives local and regional decision making. Key elements include the capacity for institutions to make plans that are coordinated across disciplines (e.g. land-use planning and emergency management), that incorporate lessons learned from prior experience, that take into account the needs and concerns of all local population groups, and that make the link between local and regional concerns.

**Question #2:** *What are the shocks and stresses most often associated with this sector? Allow 15 minutes*

Floods, wildfires, vulnerable populations, severe weather, housing and transportation availability, fiscal instability, economic downturns,

**Question #3:** *Identify potential strategies to implement resiliency in this sector. Allow 30 minutes*

- Strategy C.1: Continue to implement Boulder County Comprehensive Plan to direct growth and development, and Boulder County and all municipalities should continue to integrate resiliency planning strategies into comprehensive planning documents.
- Strategy C.2: Identify gaps in service in the existing network of non-profits to ensure service to all populations.
- Strategy C.3: Enhance coordination between local emergency management agencies.
- Strategy C.4: Integrate communication resources for diverse cultures, and hearing-impaired and transient populations to ensure emergency service information is accessible to all.
- Strategy C.5: Develop systematic messaging at local levels targeting state leaders for accurate and coordinated communication to federal government regarding catastrophic impacts of local and regional shocks to expedite response time.
- Strategy C.6: Implement pilot projects that serve as successful models for resilient development, and provide opportunities for the public to observe the planning, design, and construction process.
