## WHAT IS A MWOA TRIP?

- These trips involve men and women who help build churches, clinics, schools, training centers, orphanages and other facilities. Trips usually last 10 to 14 days.
- MWOA volunteers pay their own travel expenses and volunteer their labor.
- MWOA projects are conducted in the USA and internationally.
- Volunteers are always needed during times of natural disaster.

## WHAT ARE THE TRIP'S OBJECTIVES?

- To meet a specific need.
- To impact the lives of those who participate in the project, those who helped you go and those who had a need met by the project.

## HOW CAN I RAISE FUNDS TO GO ON A TRIP?

- Send out personal letters to friends, family and business acquaintances.
- COMMIT yourself to the trip. People seem to help someone who has already made the commitment to go.
- Talk about your trip. You never know who is listening.

## WHAT IS THE FIRST STEP TOWARD PARTICIPATING IN A PROJECT?

- Make a commitment- send in your volunteer application form and deposit.

## HOW CAN I BE A BETTER VOLUNTEER?

- Exhibit a servant attitude in all that you do and contribute to the team effort.
- Realize that you are an example to all those you are working with- cooperate!
- Be prepared for an adventure.
- Talk it up! Excitement produces results!
- Be kind- Be patient.
- FLEXIBILITY is the key word! Things will not always work out in the expected ways.

### DISCIPLESHIP / GLOBAL FIRE ADVANCE

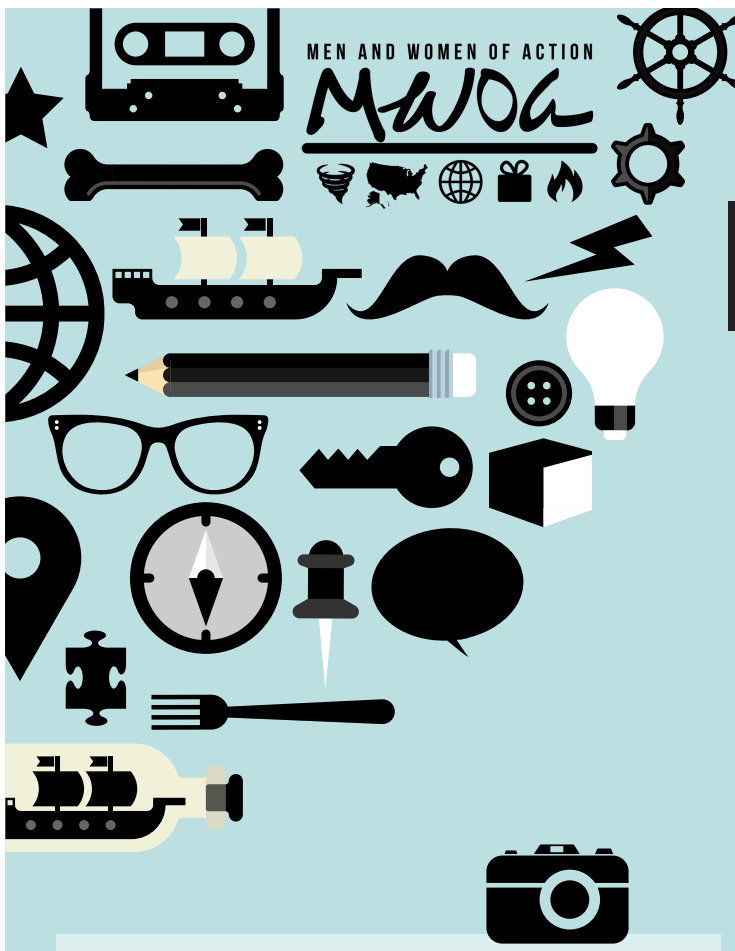
Evangelism, discipleship, and church planting through the power of the Holy Spirit.
