

RESTRICTED ITEMS / RECREATIONAL TRANSPORTATION DEVICES

HOVERBOARDS

To ensure the safety of our customers and employees, XTRA Airways **will not accept** the transport of hoverboards, balance wheels, gliders, smart scooters, or intelligent scooters of any type which use lithium or lithium-ion batteries on board our flights as carry-on or checked baggage.

E-CIGARETTES

Battery-powered portable electronic smoking devices (e.g., e-cigarettes, e-cigs, e-cigars, e-pipes, e-hookahs, personal vaporizers, electronic nicotine delivery systems) when carried by passengers or crewmembers for personal use, **must be carried in carry-on baggage only**. Recharging of the devices and/or the batteries or use of the devices on board the aircraft is not permitted (14 CFR Part 252).

In the event that a carry-on bag has to be placed below in a cargo bin due to the size of the carry-on piece or capacity of the overhead bins in the cabin, any electronic device, lithium batteries, and spare batteries permitted in carry-on baggage must be removed from the carry-on bag and remain in the possession of the passenger in the passenger cabin.

OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES/BATTERIES

Electronic devices such as cell phones, computers, tablets, or any other device with batteries as well as spare lithium/lithium-ion batteries must be removed from checked baggage. These items may be carried on the aircraft in carry-on baggage. Spare lithium batteries must be packaged to prevent short circuit.
