If you want to create shade without blocking your view of the garden, go for a simple roller blind in a neutral sheer fabric. Pictured in Natural Linen, this design from Bloc Blinds also comes with the unique Fabric Changer system, which features hook-on, hook-off technology so you can change the fabric of your blind as often as you like without having to replace the entire mechanism. The H150xW240cm design pictured costs £206.

▼ Beautifully bespoke

Finding off-the-peg solutions for awkwardly shaped windows can be difficult to achieve, and a made-to-measure design is often the better option, creating a more streamlined look that's perfectly tailored to your space. Grand Design Blinds' manual pleated blinds pull from the bottom up and there are no top rails spanning the window, as this could ruin the beauty of the full-height gable. Prices start from £1,800 for a bespoke design.



▲ Colour block

Preventing heat from escaping during the colder months is essential for a warm and cosy home, so fitting a full-length curtain that can be pulled across your front door can be an effective and eye-catching way to stop heat leaking out through any gaps around the frame or through the letterbox. For added impact, this Lovebirds fabric in Blossom, £17.99 per m, has been teamed with a contrasting trim in plain Panama fabric in Claret, £13.99 per m, both from Prestigious Textiles.
