Dear Chancellor Bouchard:

Pursuant to Chancery Rule 5.1(f) and this Court's February 2, 2017 Order (trans. no. 60153172), Senator Colin Bonini of the State of Delaware hereby objects to the *Custodian's Motion to Close the Courtroom During the February 7, 2017 Hearing* filed on February 2, 2017 (the "Motion").

The Letter's confidentiality does not dictate a closing of the Hearing to the public. *Al Jazeera Am., LLC v. AT&T Servs.*, C.A. No. 8823-VCG, 2013 Del. Ch. LEXIS 248, at *10 (Ch. Oct. 14, 2013) (observing that the fact that information "previously [was kept] undisclosed does not alone warrant confidential treatment.").

Public confidence in the courts quickly erodes when judicial proceedings are kept clandestine. Senator Bunini has a long history of advocating for transparency in the government, and has been following this matter closely, as it presents issues that are important to his constituency. He therefore requests that the Court exercise its discretion, deny the Motion, and keep the Hearing open to the public.
