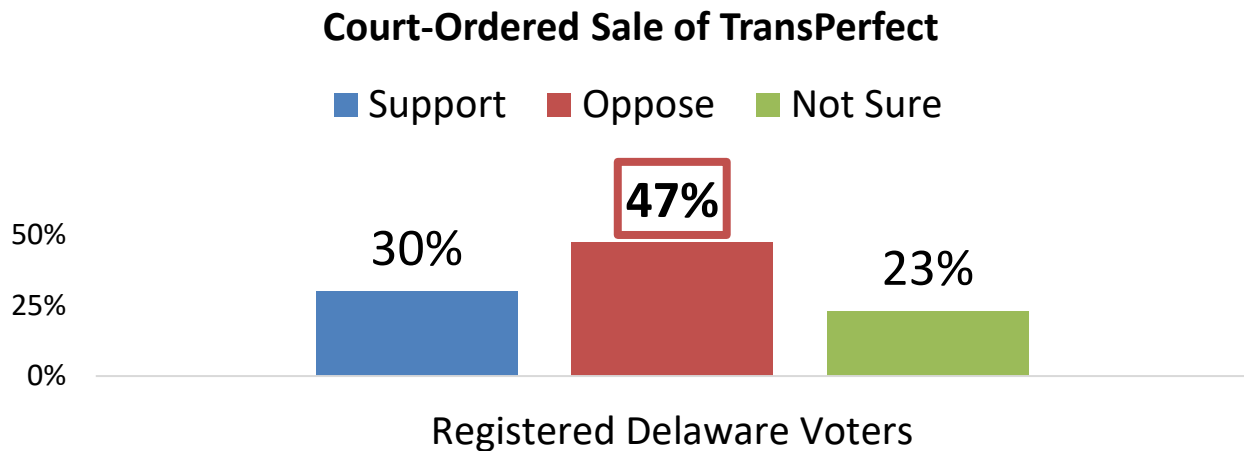

RE: **TRANSPERFECT DISPUTE POLLING**

Slingshot Strategies, LLC. conducted **polling** with a **representative statewide sample** of registered Delaware voters testing perceptions and preferences about the **ongoing dispute involving TransPerfect Global**, as well as attitudes towards the incorporation services industry generally.

We found that **nearly half (47%) of Delaware voters oppose the court-ordered sale of TransPerfect, while less than a third (30%) support the sale.**



Further, our poll found **widespread support for limits on government interference** with Delaware companies, government responsibility for direct consequences of the TransPerfect ruling, and the need to pass legislation addressing the TransPerfect dispute:

- **71% of voters** believe that the **government should not have the power to force the sale** of a Delaware company against the wishes of its employees and 50% of its shareholders;
- **72% of voters** believe the government should try to **save some of the jobs** that could be lost as a result of the court-ordered sale of TransPerfect;
- **73% of voters** want the **Delaware General Assembly** to pass legislation that clarifies how courts should handle complicated situations like the TransPerfect dispute;
- **94% of voters** believe it is **important for Delaware to continue to attract businesses** to incorporate in our state.

*From March 9th to March 14th, 2017, Slingshot Strategies surveyed 800 Delaware voters, utilizing mixed-mode sampling capturing landline, mobile, and online respondents.*
