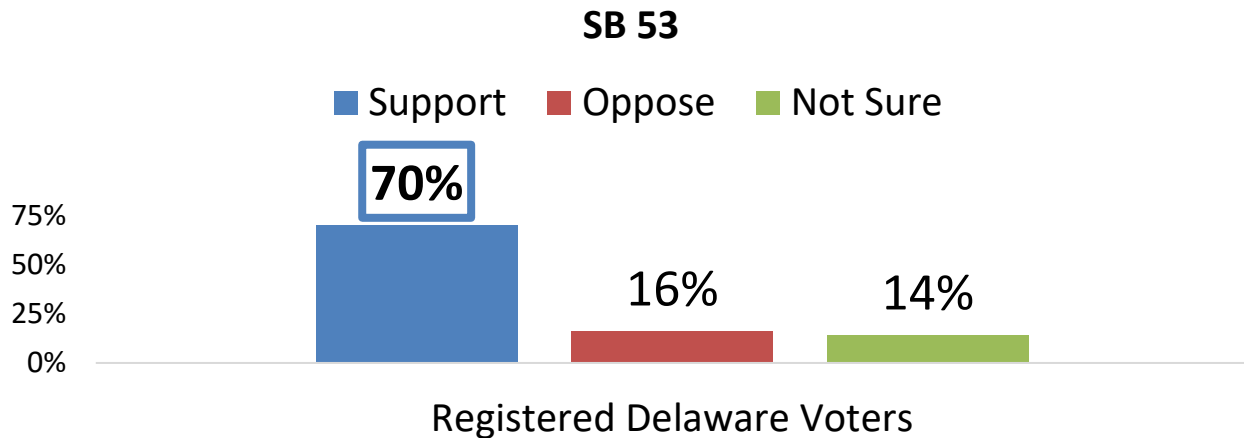

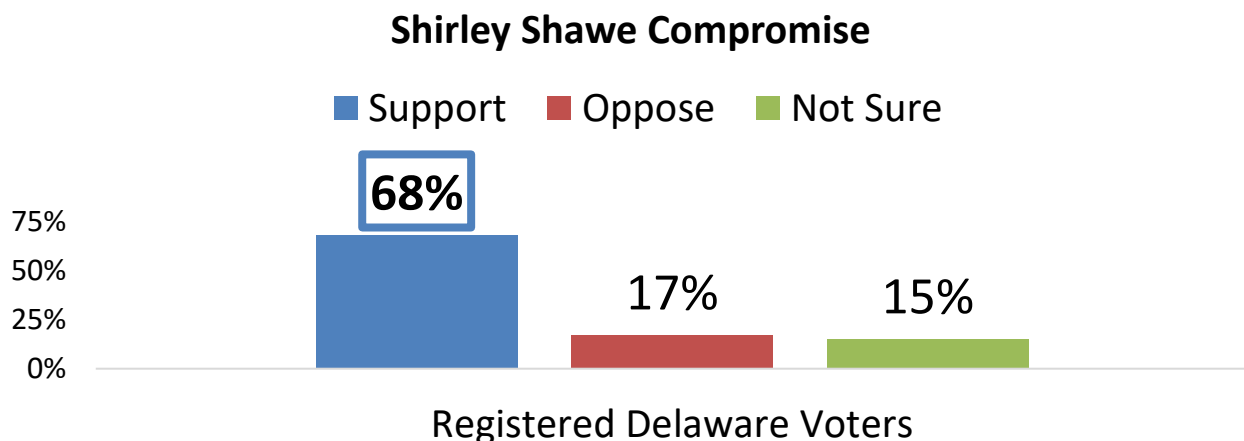
RE: **TRANSPERFECT DISPUTE POLLING**

Slingshot Strategies, LLC. conducted polling with a representative statewide sample of registered Delaware voters testing perceptions and preferences about the ongoing dispute involving TransPerfect Global, as well as proposed legislation and solutions addressing the dispute.

We found that **70% of Delaware voters support SB 53, which would require the Delaware Court of Chancery to wait three years before it can order the sale of a profitable Delaware company such as TransPerfect**, while only 16% oppose the bill.



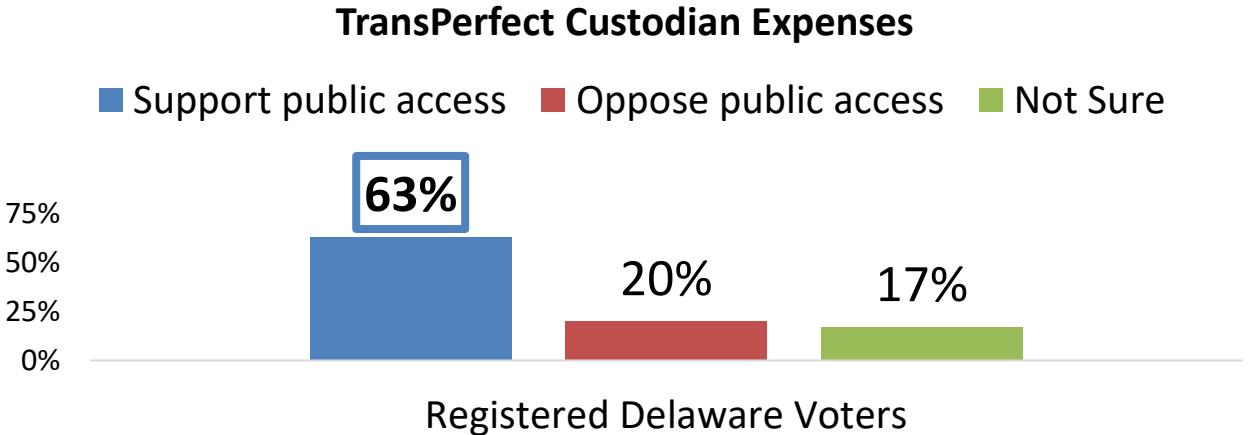
Further, our poll found that **68% of voters support Shirley Shawe's compromise proposal** to vote her 1% ownership interest with co-CEO Liz Elting in order to prevent TransPerfect from being sold, while only 17% oppose Shawe's proposed compromise.



Delaware voters do not believe that that Shirley Shawe should be sanctioned by the court for proposing a solution to the court-ordered sale of TransPerfect, and **only 28% of voters** support Elting’s request for sanctions against Shawe.

A large majority of Delaware voters support **transparency on TransPerfect’s custodian expenses**, with **63% of voters** supporting **public access and court approval for all \$18 million in custodian fees** and expenses charged to TransPerfect.



**67% of Delaware voters** believe that **competition from states like Wyoming** is a compelling reason to support a **business-friendly resolution to the TransPerfect dispute** that prevents the incorporation services sector from fleeing Delaware to other states.
