IN A MEDICAL EMERGENCY

If possible ask guest if they need an ambulance - if not call 911 for an ambulance. A host should accompany the guest to the hospital. If a sufficient number of hosts are not present to permit one to go to the hospital, call the back-up volunteer or congregation coordinator to accompany guest or meet guest at hospital. The accompanying host or backup volunteer must report back as soon as possible concerning medical status and arrangements.
