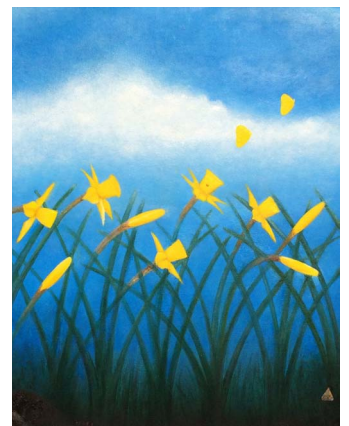

- Participants may sit one Saturday at the gallery during exhibit.
- Artwork must be framed or gallery wrapped with wire hangers.
- Sculptors may be asked to provide their own pedestals.
- Include at least one digital image of current artwork with form.
- Up to 8 pieces of art should be available at time of show.
- Attendance at opening is highly recommended.
