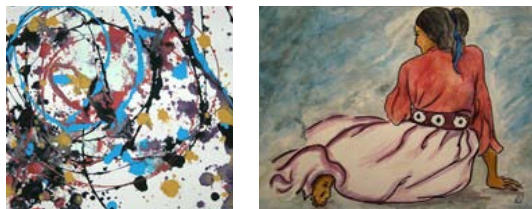
El Paso Scenes Show at Sunland Art Gallery

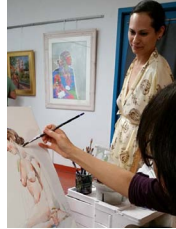

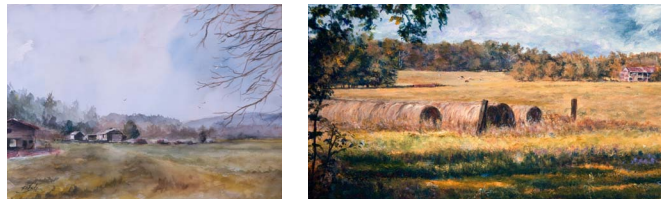

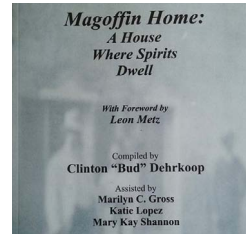
