Through the first Tetra volunteer, the notion of creating assistive devices for those in need began to spread widely across North America. Over the years, Tetra has spread throughout eastern Canada where we proudly host one of the Chapters.

Our chapter is a student run group that works with a wide range of medical conditions, ages, and needs to create assistive devices for individuals with disabilities. In addition to that we have students placed with a variety of health professionals in Hospital and research environments. Through our projects, students are constantly being challenged to put their technical skill set to the test. Each term, new design teams are recruited in order to assist our clients.


