Nurturing Community

- A small, nurturing community of about 45 students.
- Class size of 15 students.
- Advisory group of 8 students that meet with advisory teacher weekly
- The DCMS Community values and fosters Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, Self-control, Kindness, and Perseverance.
- Our student leaders, called Caciques, lead morning meeting, provide tours, and act as role models.

- All newly accepted students are required to attend a week long half-day summer orientation program during the last two weeks in August. Please do not make any holiday arrangements during this time, as your child must participate in this summer school.

6. All accepted students are required to attend a 7 day summer orientation program during the last two weeks of August. Please do not make any holiday arrangements during this time, as your child must participate in this summer school program.
