### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Dream the Dream Scholarship will be awarded to three (3) high school graduating seniors.
- Two (2) awards will be granted to students currently residing in the New York City Area; and one (1) award will be granted to an at-large student currently residing anywhere in the nation.
- Applicants must reside in the USA and must plan to further his/her education in the United States.
- Scholarship winners will be notified, June 22, 2018 via email.
- Recipients from the New York City Area must be available to attend a fundraising event on Saturday, June 30, 2018 in New York City. More details regarding the awards presentation will be disseminated upon the announcement of the scholarship winners.
- Scholarship winners will also be required to submit a copy of his/her institutional acceptance letter as well as a copy of the first semester/term's billing statement. Scholarship funds will be disbursed in full upon the submission of the requirements.
- Scholarship awards can range from \$100 book incentives to \$1,000 grants based on fund contributions and recipient disbursements.

### THE NOMINEE SHOULD BE A STUDENT WHO:

- Has a cumulative grade point average of 2.2 or above on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent
- Is in need of financial assistance
- Possesses high potential for leadership and for contributing to society
- Is recommended by someone from the community with knowledge of the nominee's qualifications
- Is a high school graduating senior with plans to pursue a higher education in the Fall of 2018 at any American accredited university, college, technical school, or vocational institution
