MacBook Air Loan Agreement

One Apple MacBook Air, charger and case are being lent to the Student and are in good working order. It is the Student's responsibility to care for the equipment and ensure that it is retained in a safe environment.

The equipment is, and at all times remains, the Property of the Global Impact STEM Academy and is herewith lent to the Student for educational purposes only for the Academic School Year. The student may not deface or destroy this property in any way. Inappropriate use of the machine may result in the student losing their privilege to use the MacBook Air. The equipment will be returned when requested by the Global Impact STEM Academy, or sooner, if the student withdraws from the Global Impact STEM Academy prior to the end of the school year.

The District Property may be used by the Student only for noncommercial purposes, in accordance with District's policies and rules, the District Acceptable Use Policy, as well as local, state, and federal statutes.

Student may not install or use any software other than software owned or approved by the District and made available to the Student in accordance with this Receipt and Agreement.

One user with specific privileges and capabilities has been set up on the MacBook Air for the exclusive use of the Student to which it has been assigned. The Student agrees to make no attempts to change or allow others to change the privileges and capabilities of this user account.

The Student may not make any attempt to add, delete access, or modify other users' accounts on the MacBook Air or on any school owned computer. The Global Impact STEM Academy network is provided for the academic use of all students and staff.

The Student agrees to take no action that would interfere with the efficient, academic use of the network.

Identification labels have been placed on the MacBook Air. These labels are not to be removed or modified. If they become damaged or missing, please contact tech support for replacements. Additional stickers, labels, tags or markings of any kind are not to be added to the machine.

An email account will be available for each student to use for appropriate academic communication with other students and staff members only. This email account is for communication within the school district or for educational purposes only.

Student agrees to use best efforts to assure that the District Property is not damaged or rendered inoperable by any such electronic virus while in Student's possession.

The Student acknowledges and agrees that the Student's use of the District Property is a privilege and that by the Student's agreement to the terms hereof, the Student acknowledges the Student's responsibility to protect and safeguard the District Property and to return the same in good condition repair upon request by the Global Impact STEM Academy.

Maintenance and Repair:

Please thoroughly read this section to fully understand you and your child's protection against damage and loss of the loaned MacBook Air in your care. Acknowledgment of your understanding of this form must be completed before the MacBook Air will be provided to the student. This acknowledgement is part of the orientation packet.

Coverage

This agreement covers the MacBook Air loaned to the student against all damage or loss to his or her issued device. **Accessories (charger and case) are NOT covered and are the sole responsibility of the student.** Coverage is 24 hours per day. Lost and/or damaged accessories may be assessed to a student's fees.

Effective and Expiration

This agreement is effective from the date this required form and technology-leasing fee are received by the school through the date at which the MacBook Air is required to be returned in good order to the school.

Technology Leasing Fee

The total technology-leasing fee is \$100.00 for the 2016/2017 school year. This fee is not refundable. It is agreed and understood that:

- If a student does not pay the technology insurance fee and turn in completed paperwork they will not be allowed to take their MacBook Air off school property.
- A separate agreement will be needed for each MacBook Air.
- If a student damages a MacBook Air beyond repair or loses the MacBook Air, a replacement MacBook Air will only be issued one additional time.
- In the event a MacBook Air or its accessories are lost or stolen, a police report must be filed and a copy provided to the Global Impact STEM Academy before a replacement is issued.
- If computer damage is intentional, students may be required to pay for the entire device and waive their privilege to utilize this insurance protection.

It will be the responsibility of the administration to determine if damages were due to negligence or accidental. A student with a damaged MacBook Air will be given a replacement. If the MacBook Air or its replacement is damaged, lost or stolen a second time, the student will not be permitted to take the MacBook Air outside of the building for one calendar year.
