Thig and Lauren Gishuru and their three children settled in Madison Park less than one year ago, but in that short time, have found a strong community of friends and neighbors who feel like family.

The fact that the family fell hard for Madison Park was no surprise to Lauren, who grew up on Queen Anne but spent a lot of time in the neighborhood during middle school and high school: "It was always the fun place to hang out with friends. You'd love to get invited to a friend's house in Madison Park," she said.

Thig grew up in nearby Lakeridge and attended schools on Beacon Hill. Both of his parents emigrated to the United States from Kenya through the same Catholic program that brought Barack Obama Sr. to the States. It was through that program that both Thig and his father attended O'Dea High School on Capitol Hill.

After high school, Thig attended Central Washington University, where he earned a degree in business. Lauren graduated from the University of Oregon's School of Journalism and Communication.

Since graduating, Lauren has worked in the early stages of tech startups, while Thig started his career in health care administration and eventually shifted to a creative director role at a Capitol Hill agency.

The couple originally met through a mutual friend and talked on social media for a few months. It took a while for the two to start dating as Lauren was a single mom to her then 3-year-old son Miles and working in tech.

Thig was also busy with work and his passion project, a band called The Physics, that he started with two fellow O'Dea students.

The couple got engaged in 2015 and married one year later. The celebration was at Axis in Pioneer Square - better known as the former Elliott Bay Books.

Seven years later, the two are busy working and taking care of their three children, Miles, Noah, and Samara or "Sammy."

Their oldest, Miles, is 11 years old and attends SAAS: "[He] is our classic firstborn ... very independent and responsible," Lauren said. An entrepreneur, Miles has recently started businesses to run in his free time. He sold artwork during the

coronavirus lockdown, raked leaves for neighbors, and is now starting his own candle-making business.

Noah is 4 years old and nicknamed "the Mayor." He knows every neighbor on the street, some of whom his parents don't even know. When he is not saying hello to his constituents, Noah loves attending Acro and hip-hop dance classes. Outside of class, Noah is always moving, dancing, and perfecting his cartwheels.

Sammy is 2 years old and is the couple's "Covid baby." Thig described Sammy as an "extremely smart, bright kid" who "wears her heart on her sleeve." She loves dancing and playing with her brother, Noah.

Madison Park has proved a great fit for both the Gishuru parents and kids.

"It feels tucked away from the city in a way that feels like you are almost on vacation," Thig said. When he is working from home, Thig loves to take walks through the neighborhood and enjoys seeing the mix of colorful nature and unique architecture.

This walkability has been great for the family who enjoys going to the Beaver Sanctuary and stopping by Madison Park Bakery for a treat.

On these walks, they are bound to see a neighbor that they (or at least Noah) knows, which Lauren finds refreshing: "We haven't had neighbor friends like this in the past," she said. " ... It's nice to feel like you're in a community, especially with Covid and working remotely. These are our social touchpoints."

One great social connector for the family has been the basketball hoop they have in their front yard. Gifted to them by neighbors whose son went off to college, Lauren was initially concerned that neighbors might find the hoop in the street a nuisance. But the opposite has been true. Neighbors have thanked her for putting it out, saying that it would encourage passing cars to drive more slowly and saying that their kids look forward to playing with it.

So, she got to baking and over the next few months learned the unique science of bagel making, developing her own, unique recipes.

Less than a year later she makes and sells six different kinds of bagels, as well as six unique cream cheese spreads. Her bestsellers are her everything bagel - which makes up two-thirds of her business and her garlic and scallion cream cheese.

Despite the many challenges Christina faced during the birth of her business, she sees ample rewards when hosting pop-ups at different Seattle restaurants and breweries: "It kept

me going that it made people happy. That at every pop-up I [did], I would meet a little girl or a person or four people and they were so happy about it. They were so excited that they were getting a bagel," she said. She cherishes the reactions of customers and loves to nurture them with her homemade creations.

Though her business is primarily through pop-ups, during the new year, Christina hopes to establish a bagel delivery service and also hopes to start catering events.

Christina is also donating 5% of the proceeds of her business to charity and donating day-old bagels to the afterschool program at Franklin High School.

With a passion for people and a unique determination to try something new, Christina Rossetti Darling created Darling and Co Bagels. And now, less than a year after its conception, she continues to succeed in making her customers smile with her delicious creations.

McGilvra **SCHOOL PTA**

Since 1913, McGilvra Elementary School has been serving kids and families in Madison Park. More than a century later, the public school educates more than 200 students each year and relies not only on teachers and staff but on an active PTA for vital support.

The McGilvra PTA works hard every year to raise money, plan events and support the kids and teachers of McGilvra School. Neala Kendall, the current president of the PTA, and her colleagues Molly Norton and Lara Pomernacki each have children at the school and feel passionate about supporting a school that has so thoughtfully nurtured their children.

"I've been really thrilled to see my kids just love going to school and [be] excited about doing some of their homework and [think] of learning as fun," Norton said.

It's both this nurturing school environment and a lack of funding for public schools that makes the events and community-building the PTA does so important.

The PTA typically hosts a move-a-thon, a carnival, a spring auction, and a bingo night each year to help



raise additional funds for the school. More recently, they have also planned community cleanups around Madison Park in an effort to be a more active force in the community.

The McGilvra PTA is also looking to create a McGilvra alumni network to further strengthen this unique school's ties. Because of the school's long history, "It's not totally unheard of for a grandparent and a parent and a kid to have all gone to McGilvra," Pomernacki said.

While Kendall did not attend McGilvra herself, she has also benefitted from the strength of the McGilvra family: "Since my kids have started school, I have a new set of friends and a stronger community that I've really benefited from and appreciated," she said.

Having seen the great impact McGilvra has had on their children, members of the McGilvra PTA hope that Madison Park will continue to embrace McGilvra as a longstanding pillar of the community. Miller teaches statistics, science, and calculus. She got her start one morning while she was driving to her engineering job when she heard on NPR that the Colorado College was offering a master's program for math and science teachers. She recalls the experience she had a meeting with the college's department chair soon after as a bit of a wake-up call.

He asked her about her experience in the classroom, and she told him that she only had very limited experience as a tutor. He expressed that he'd have strong reservations about accepting her application without any previous experience but told her that if she completed a six-week assistant teaching position, he'd be able to accept her into the master's program.

"It was very interesting that somebody gave me the cold hard facts," Miller said. She appreciated that since she had a somewhat fickle desire to teach, at first. However, about three weeks into the assistant teaching position in an algebra classroom, she had decided this was what she wanted to do.

This is Miller's 12th year at the Bush School, and she has enjoyed the community that she has found there:

"I had a new family," Miller said. "I recall looking around, and, in comparison to other places that I'd worked at, the school was so kind, very welcoming to people who had families ... I work with a really kind group of people that are extremely giving of their talents and their time."

The ongoing unpleasantness of the pandemic hasn't stopped Miller from bringing excellent education to her students." Being back has been a breath of relief," she said. Miller and the other educators at Bush are very grateful to be back in the classroom. While at-home learning was an adjustment they made in the moment, Miller thinks the unique opportunity ultimately gave teachers



more tools for supporting their students. She believes that the math department can use this as an opportunity to reassess the way they analyze the students' understanding of concepts.

"The hardest part [of teaching stats] is the kids always get to ask, 'What's in it for me? When am I going to use this?" Miller said. Recently she has brought more real-life, experiential datasets to the classroom, showing where data can intersect with their lives. "It's easier to learn when they have a real-world application."

Luckily, Miller loves teaching math. She loves these challenging questions and loves having conversations with her students about the motivations behind math.

Outside of the classroom, Miller loves to travel, surf, and hike with her family.

Miller's work at the Bush School doesn't go unappreciated, and we're grateful to have her as a part of the Madison Park teaching community!






