BIBLE READING GUIDE

- It's good to read the whole Bible, not just the parts we prefer.
- Trying to read the Bible in one year can often mean we rush through certain parts, two years gives us more time to take it all in.
- Try to read your Bible in the morning, otherwise it tends to not happen. Being planned and methodical with your Bible reading doesn't mean you're being religious, it just means you're prioritising your time with God.
- Some days, Bible reading may be tough going, persist! the gold will be revealed.
- Try and use a paper Bible, digital Bibles are great, but we can tend to be distracted by technology. Write in your Bible, underline things that stand out!
- Some good Bible translations to buy are NLT, NIV, NKJV, NASB, ESV. 'The Message' translation is also a great paraphrase to see the Bible through fresh eyes.
- Bibles can be purchased in the Church foyer, online or at 'Manna' bookstore in Lower Hutt
- Don't forget to pray before you read the Bible, asking the Holy Spirit to make the written Word of God come alive!

We pray in 2017, you will know God in a greater way, as you make time to seek Him!
