CONNECT QUESTIONS

What do you think is the coolest way of saying hello?

Describe a time where you experienced your biggest adrenaline rush of your life.

Revelation 2:7 “He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”

This passage of scripture is repeated many times in the book of Revelation (**2:11, 17, 29; 3:5, 13, 22**). Jesus is alive today and is speaking to us through the Holy Spirit. Why do you think John (the writer of Revelation) placed so much emphasis on this statement?

God is after our ears – he wants to speak to his people! What do you think it means to hear from God?

God speaks to us through His Word – the Bible. Check out **Job 33:14**. Why do you think we sometimes don't recognise God's voice? How can we ensure that we recognise His voice daily? What role does the Word of God play in your life when you want to know what God is saying?

Check out **Matthew 7:21-23** and **Galatians 5:19-23**. There can be things in our lives that can stop or limit us in hearing God's voice – Paul is quite straight up about what these things are! Why do you think sin gets in the way of us hearing God's voice?

Check out **Romans 12:1-2** and **Colossians 3:1-25**. What are some keys to seeing the fruit of the Spirit (**Galatians 5:22**) being outworked in our lives? How can we ensure we keep changing to become more and more like Jesus? Are there things in our lives we need to get rid of or get help to address?

Ps. Sam Soukotta talked about being faithful with what God has placed in our hands. He talked about the importance of giving (tithing) and that when we do this, we align ourselves with the blessing of God. Check out **Malachi 3:8-10**. Why do you think giving is such a key to living under an open heaven? Why can it often be hard to give? How would you describe the way you approach tithes and offerings – are there any areas in your finances that need to shift?
