IMPORTANT VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

It is a district requirement that **volunteers who may have potential for direct, unsupervised contact with students** must be screened for a criminal background. Volunteers must protect themselves as well as others by filing out a Criminal History Verification Form, which can be found online at <https://volunteer.pps.net> before volunteering in the school building or on field trips.

This verification needs to be renewed every 3 years and will be kept on file with Security Services at the district office. You can check to see if your verification is still current online at <http://volunteer.pps.net>. If you don't have access to a computer, you can fill out your criminal background check or check your verification at the main office. There is no fee for processing applications.

Because Criminal History Verification forms contain confidential information, the PTSA will not keep copies. Results of the background checks will be made available electronically only to the school principal and secretary.
