### ADDITIONAL FEES & DISCOUNTS

APPLICATION FEE	\$100 (applicants will be charged an additional fee through the ISEE testing service <a href="http://iseetest.org">iseetest.org</a> ) Non-refundable one time only fee due at time of application
REGISTRATION FEE	<b>\$350 (non-refundable)</b>
LATE FEES	<b>\$35</b> Tuition and fees are due by the 1 <sup>st</sup> of each month. A \$35 late fee per student will be assessed to past due accounts.
INSUFFICIENT FUNDS/ RETURNED PAYMENT FEE	<b>\$30</b> There is a \$30 fee charged for any returned checks or statement of insufficient funds.
LAB & ART FEES	<b>\$75 (\$77 if using credit card option)</b> Students enrolled in Middle and High School Art and Science classes will be assessed a \$75 fee per semester.
CO-CURRICULAR FEES	<b>Varies.</b> Participation in co-curricular activities may have additional fees to cover supplies, uniforms, coaching & directing stipends, chaperones, etc. Costs vary but some programs offer fundraising programs or payment plans to offset fees. Examples of these fees include (but are not limited to): <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Field Trips</li><li>• Overnight Trips</li><li>• Yearbooks</li><li>• Athletics</li><li>• Performing Arts</li><li>• Class Pictures</li><li>• Academic Clubs &amp; Programs</li></ul>
WITHDRAWAL	Families are responsible for the <b>entire semester's tuition</b> , whether or not your child is in attendance. This includes student expulsions. Withdrawal notices received after <b>June 1, 2017</b> will be responsible

## PAST DUE ACCOUNTS

for the full first semester tuition. Withdrawal notices received after **November 2, 2017** will be responsible for the full second semester tuition.

Families with past due accounts **may not** be able to participate in co-curricular activities such as extended care, arts, athletics, field trips, leadership, etc. until the account has been brought current.
