ADDITIONAL FEES & DISCOUNTS

APPLICATION FEE	\$100 (applicants will be charged an additional fee through the ISEE testing service iseetest.org) Non-refundable one time only fee due at time of application
REGISTRATION FEE	\$250 (non-refundable) Before and including March 1, 2018 \$350 (non-refundable) March 2, 2018 and thereafter
LATE FEES	\$35 Tuition and fees are due by the 1 st of each month. A \$35 late fee per student will be assessed to past due accounts.
INSUFFICIENT FUNDS/ RETURNED PAYMENT FEE	\$30 There is a \$30 fee charged for any returned checks or statement of insufficient funds.
LAB & ART FEES	\$50 (\$51.43 if using credit card option) Students enrolled in Middle and High School Art and Science classes will be assessed a \$50 fee per semester.
CO-CURRICULAR FEES	Varies. Participation in co-curricular activities may have additional fees to cover supplies, uniforms, coaching & directing stipends, chaperones, etc. Costs vary but some programs offer fundraising programs or payment plans to offset fees. Examples of these fees include (but are not limited to): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Field Trips• Overnight Trips• Yearbooks• Athletics• Performing Arts• Class Pictures• Academic Clubs & Programs



WITHDRAWAL	Families are responsible for the entire semester's tuition , whether or not your child is in attendance. This includes student expulsions. Withdrawal notices received after May 1, 2018 will be responsible for the full first semester tuition. Withdrawal notices received after November 1, 2018 will be responsible for the full second semester tuition.
PAST DUE ACCOUNTS	Families with past due accounts may not be able to participate in co-curricular activities such as extended care, arts, athletics, field trips, leadership, etc. until the account has been brought current.
TEXTBOOKS & CURRICULUM COSTS	High School Only (grades 9-12) Varies: approximately \$250-\$400 Students will be responsible for acquiring their own books and curriculum. Curriculum may include: online content, Bound Textbook or Workbook, and Free Content. Families will own what they purchase and will have the option to see the textbook after the course is done.
TECHNOLOGY FEE	\$100-200 (pending) Upper Elementary and Middle School (Grades 5-8) students may be assessed a technology fee for the use of 1:1 Apple iPads (pending agreement with Apple).
