Princess, Inc. is a non-profit, mentoring and community service organization that seeks to empower and develop young, at risk teenage girls of color in Atlantic City, New Jersey and surrounding areas.

What age group does Princess, Inc. serve?

We serve young ladies ages 13-19 years old.

How long has Princess, Inc. been operating?

The organization has been operating since 2011. We were incorporated in the state of New Jersey and recognized federally as a 501(c)3 organization since 2012.

How can I become a Princess, Inc. member?

Candidates must be nominated by a member of the community and complete the application process which includes an interview. Nominations can be sent to princessincofac@gmail.com

How can I nominate someone to join Princess, Inc.?

A nomination form must be completed by visiting our website www.princessinc.org. Included questions on form will include why the student is a great fit for Princess, Inc.; why she should be considered and familial and parental dedication.

Is there an application fee? If so, what is the cost?

Yes. The fee is \$50



Is Princess, Inc. membership and acceptance a revolving process?

No. In order to allow for a diverse group of interested young ladies to foster true bonding and for maximum continuity of the program within each cohort, the nomination process only happens once every four years. Members from previous cohorts may however roll over. It is our hope that as young ladies start a new cohort, they commit to being active members of Princess, Inc. for four to five (4-5) consecutive years- leading up to their high school graduation.

How else may my child be involved and/or connect to Princess, Inc.?

If your child needs to develop a community service portfolio, Princess, Inc. is the resource for that! We also have various opportunities and resources for students who are in need of dental/cosmetic work and students with no disciplinary history may be eligible to receive "tuition free" college scholarships.
