HOT AIR BALLOON GOURD ORNAMENT

Instructor: Grace Swanson



Description: Students will learn to draw and then burn a geometric design on a small gourd. They will then use gourd dyes to color the gourd. A small basket will be attached to the bottom of the gourd and a pounded copper wire hanger will be attached. Students should be able to finish 2 hot air balloon gourds. Approx. finished size: 5"

Materials supplied: Gourds, small woven baskets, dyes, gloves, paint brushes, copper wire, chasing hammer and steel block (to share).

Special Requirements & Tools to bring--- Must have: A Wood Burner – any kind will do, but no previous experience is needed.

Description: Learn how to use Lauhala from Hawaii, while learning how to weave a hibiscus and an arum lily

All materials supplied.

Tools to bring: spray bottle, paring knife, scissors, small clips.

BOW BASKET

Description: Come and learn basic basket weaving techniques. The results will be a flat splint basket designed to be hung on a wall peg. (It will sit too) 8"x 5", H:11"

Materials supplied: Everything

Tools to bring: Bucket to soak materials, towel, basket scissors, awl, tape measure.

Minimum 4 Max 10 All levels

RUSTIC BOAT BASKET

Instructor: Polly Jacobs Giacchina



Description: Use twining to weave a boat shaped vessel. Multiple materials will be chosen (see material list) or you can bring a few of your own weavers and embellishments to accent the piece. We will discuss scale of material and the endless possibilities of twining.

Approx. Finished size: 20" x 5"

Materials supplied: round reed, soaked date palm, large hemp, sea grass, coconut fiber and smaller twine to start the weaving. Some embellishments or you can bring a few of your own.

Tools to bring: sharp scissors or small clippers and a small awl-if you have one.
Minimum 3 Maximum 10 All levels

Class Fee: \$45.

JAPANESE BASKET #10

Instructor: Willie Ziegler



Description: Reed basket--open woven base with 3/1 twill sides. Self rim is looped and interwoven into body. Approx. size: 6" long x 4" wide x 5" high

Materials supplied: Reed

Tools to bring: Towel, packing tool (if owned), small scissors, ruler or tape measure. There will be a soaking tub available.

Minimum 1 Maximum 7 Beginners

Class Fee: \$35.
