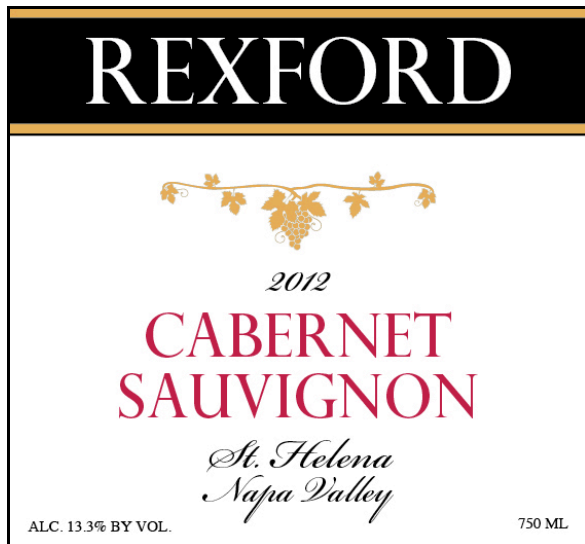


REXFORD WINERY

2012 CABERNET SAUVIGNON *Saint Helena, Napa Valley*



Harvest date: October 9

Brix: 22.4

Vinification: Crushed and destemmed immediately. Fermented in one-ton lots and punched down by hand twice daily.

Alcohol: 13.3% by volume

Barrels: French and American Oak, 30% new

Fining, filtering: none

Bottling date: Aug 6, 2014

Cases produced: 146

Suggested Retail Price: \$30

Vineyard and wine notes:

We sourced this Cabernet Sauvignon from a small vineyard near Zinfandel Lane in the heart of the Napa Valley. This bottling represents the entire production of the vineyard in 2012. Our goal was to make an old fashioned Cabernet that is modest in alcohol and will pair well with food. The wine has a dark ruby color and aromas of violets, licorice, a light earthiness and a hint of mint. It has rich fruit flavors of cassis and blackberries with a touch of oak. A moderate tannin structure ensures that it will be accessible immediately but we expect it to age well because of the excellent balance of fruit and acidity. With its elegant style our 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon will pair with roasts, filet mignon or venison.
