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SYNOPSIS

With her life on the line and help from her loyal bodyguard, she must escape the stalker's sinister grip before they tie the knot.



PRODUCER'S STATEMENT

We had always wanted to make a film that was reminiscent of cult classics we grew up renting from video stores and that we loved seeing in theatres. We have been long-time fans of Jimmy Warden's unique voice as a screenwriter. This was evident in the spec script he wrote, COCAINE BEAR – we loved the way this blended thrills, horror and comedy. Audiences agreed too, as COCAINE BEAR went on to make over \$89 million at the global box office. When we first read BORDERLINE, we were completely swept up in the story. The way the lives of this ensemble of characters intersect based on the grand delusions of Paul Duerson was so delightfully mad and surprising.

We are incredibly passionate about establishing new directorial voices. The script for Borderline felt so quintessentially Jimmy in its tone and voice that we could not think of anyone who could do a better job of bringing the script off the page better than Jimmy himself. That's when we all decided to collaborate to tell this story as Jimmy's directorial debut.

Jimmy assembled a wonderful ensemble of established and emerging talent to bring these characters to life, anchored by Ray Nicholson's performance as Paul Duerson. What we love so much about Jimmy's translation from script to screen is the way the design of the film and the killer soundtrack has created such a fun, nostalgic feeling. In bringing Borderline to screen, Jimmy has created something truly unique that marks the arrival of an exciting new director.

We can't wait for audiences to experience BORDERLINE.

Samara Weaving - Sofia

Samara Weaving is one of Hollywood's most promising young talents working today.

She was most recently seen in Paramount Pictures' SCREAM VI, the latest installment of the classic horror franchise. This April, she will also star in Searchlight's musical biopic CHEVALIER, based on the true story of composer Joseph Bologne, Chevalier de Saint-Georges, the illegitimate son of an African slave and a French plantation owner, who rises to heights in French society as a composer before an ill-fated love affair.

Last year, Weaving starred as the lead opposite Eugenio Derbez in the Hulu film THE VALET and joined a star-studded cast in Oscar winning director Damien Chazelle's BABYLON.

She most recently completed production on the comedic thriller BORDERLINE directed by Jimmy Warden and produced by LuckyChap Entertainment and on the action-horror film AZRAEL. Weaving will next star as Holly Madison in an adaption of her memoir "Down the Rabbit Hole" at Sony TV, Elizabeth Patterson Bonaparte in new biopic LIZ, and in the action thriller BELLA for Paramount Pictures.

This summer, Weaving will begin production on the Netflix comedy series LITTLE SKY.

In 2021, she starred in Hulu's eight-part limited series NINE PERFECT STRANGERS alongside executive producer's Nicole Kidman and Melissa McCarthy. She was also seen in Paramount's long-awaited GI Joe spin off SNAKE EYES.

Weaving made waves in Searchlight's horror comedy READY OR NOT in which THE WRAP called "a star-making performance."

Her other credits include BILL & TED FACE THE MUSIC opposite Keanu Reeves, Netflix's award-winning limited series HOLLYWOOD, created by Ryan Murphy, Amazon's Mini-Series PICNIC AT HANGING ROCK for Fremantle Media, alongside Natalie Dormer, Lola Bessis and Lily Sullivan, which follows three schoolgirls and their governess after they disappear on Valentine's Day 1900, and Searchlight Pictures' THREE BILLBOARDS OUTSIDE EBBING, MISSOURI opposite Frances McDormand, Woody Harrelson and Sam Rockwell. Directed by Martin McDonagh, the film was nominated for a 2018 Academy Award for "Best Picture." The film also

received a Golden Globe for "Best Motion Picture – Drama" and the Screen Actors Guild Award for "Outstanding Performance by a Cast in a Motion Picture." In

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2017, Weaving starred in McG's **THE BABYSITTER** for Netflix, and also appeared in the 2020 sequel, **THE BABYSITTER: KILLER QUEEN**.

She began her career on the long-running hit Australian series **HOME AND AWAY** and went on to star as Peggy in Ivan Sen's **MYSTERY ROAD** (2013) opposite Ryan Kwanten and Aaron Pedersen. Other past credits include **ASH VS. EVIL DEAD** produced by Sam Raimi, the Australian film's **BAD GIRL** (2016) and **BEFORE DAWN** (2017) as well as the television shows **SQUIRREL BOYS**, **OUT OF THE BLUE**, and **THE WRIGHT STUFF**.

Ray Nicholson - Duerson

Ray Nicholson can most recently be seen in **SOMETHING FROM TIFFANY'S** opposite Zoey Deutch and Kendrick Sampson, produced by Lauren Neustadter and Reese Witherspoon's **Hello Sunshine** for Amazon. Previously, Ray wrapped shooting a pivotal supporting role opposite Willem Dafoe and Patricia Arquette in Patricia's directorial debut **GONZO GIRL**. Prior to this, he shot the lead role in **BORDERLINE** written and directed by Jimmy Warden, opposite Samara Weaving and Eric Dane for LuckyChap. Ray can be seen as the lead of Neil LaBute's **OUT OF THE BLUE** opposite Diane Kruger and can also be seen as "Ray", the male-lead of the series **PANIC**, based on Lauren Oliver's best-selling novel, produced by Joe Roth and Jeff Kirschenbaum for Amazon. Jimmy Fails- Rhodes

Jimmie Fails made his feature debut as both an actor and writer in the critically acclaimed A24 film, **THE LAST BLACK MAN IN SAN FRANCISCO**, which premiered at Sundance 2019, where it won awards for Best Directing and a Special Jury Prize for Creative Collaboration. Jimmie co-wrote the screenplay with his best friend and longtime collaborator, Joe Talbot, who also directed. Brad Pitt's Plan B produced the film – a fable-like story based on Jimmie's life and the gentrification of San Francisco – which features an ensemble cast including Jonathan Majors, Rob Morgan, Mike Epps, Finn Wittrock, Tichina Arnold, and Danny Glover. Jimmie and Joe previously collaborated on the short film, **AMERICAN PARADISE**, which premiered at Sundance 2017 and was a creative precursor to the feature.

Most recently, Jimmie finished production on **BORDERLINE** for Margot Robbie's LuckyChap Entertainment, playing the lead role opposite Samara Weaving, Ray Nicholson, Eric Dane, and Alba Baptista.

Also upcoming, Jimmie will soon be seen starring opposite David Oyelowo in Bron Studio's **SOLITARY**, written and directed by Nate Parker.

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Jimmie's previous credits include a supporting role in Kornél Mundruczó's Academy Award-nominated feature, **PIECES OF A WOMAN**, opposite Vanessa Kirby, the lead role in the Tribeca short film, **SLOW PULSE**, written and directed by Marshall Tyler and he played "Eddie Murphy" in the Sony/TriStar feature directed by Kasi Lemmons', **I WANNA DANCE WITH SOMEBODY**, opposite Naomi Ackie, Ashton Sanders, Stanley Tucci, and Nafessa Williams.

Alba Baptista - Penny

Alba Baptista is a film and television actress. She is most known as the lead in the critically acclaimed Netflix series **WARRIOR NUN** and as the lead opposite Lesley Manville and Isabelle Huppert in the Focus Features film **MRS. HARRIS GOES TO PARIS**, which released in US theaters on July 15, 2022. Alba recently wrapped production for the LuckyChap Entertainment film **BORDERLINE**, written and directed by Jimmy Warden.

Alba started her career as the main character in Simão Cayatte's **MIAMI**. For her performance she received the Best Actress Award at the Festival Ibérico de Ciné. During the following years, Alba developed a strong cinema career in Portugal, as well as starring in roles on three popular Portuguese series. More recently Alba was awarded the European Shooting Star award at the 2021 Berlinale.

Eric Dane - Bell

Eric Dane can currently be seen in the Emmy nominated HBO series **EUPHORIA** starring alongside Zendaya. He was nominated for a 2022 Hollywood Critics Association TV Award for "Best Supporting Actor in a Broadcast Network or Cable Series, Drama" for his performance in the show; and the series was also recently nominated for the 2023 Critics Choice Award for "Best Drama Series".

Dane recently wrapped production on LuckyChap's **BORDERLINE** and the motorcycle racing film, **ONE FAST MOVE** opposite KJ Apa. Jimmy Warden – Writer/Director

Jimmy Warden is a Chicago-born screenwriter and director. He wrote the recently released horror/comedy COCAINE BEAR, which was sold as an original spec to Universal Pictures. Elizabeth Banks directed this feature with Phil Lord, Chris Miller, and Aditya Sood producing. Jimmy is currently in post-production on his directorial debut, the dark comedy BORDERLINE, produced by Margot Robbie and LuckyChap. His screenplay for which was featured on the Black List. Previously, he produced Netflix's horror/comedy THE BABYSITTER as well as writing the sequel. He most recently wrote an UNTITLED HORROR/ZOM-EDY for Roy Lee and New Regency; and co-wrote a half-hour comedy entitled AMBASSADORS starring Matt Walsh.

Brian Duffield – Producer

Brian Duffield most recent film is NO ONE WILL SAVE YOU, which he wrote, produced and directed for 20th Century Studios. His show SKULL ISLAND also released in 2023 from Legendary Entertainment on Netflix, and Brian recently produced COCAINE BEAR for Universal Studios. Prior to that, he wrote, produced and directed SPONTANEOUS starring Katherine Langford and Charlie Plummer. Some of his previous credits as a writer include UNDERWATER, LOVE AND MONSTERS and INSURGENT.

Hadeel Reda - Producer

With over 20 years in film and TV development, distribution, and financing, including executive positions with Winchester Films and Disney, Reda has been instrumental in shaping and driving business strategy, content acquisitions, production, financing, and distribution as a visionary film executive. At Disney, where Reda got her start in Feature Film development, she quickly obtained an Executive position in the International Division for Disney's feature films, Buena Vista International. She oversaw international marketing campaigns for THE LION KING, POCAHONTAS, and Tim Burton's THE NIGHTMARE BEFORE CHRISTMAS.

Josey McNamara - Producer

Academy Award nominated producer Josey McNamara formed LuckyChap Entertainment alongside Margot Robbie and Tom Ackerley in 2014, after meeting on the set of SUITE FRANCAISE where Josey worked as an assistant director. Josey later transitioned to producing and launched LuckyChap Entertainment with the intent of telling female-driven stories and promoting new filmmakers.



Recently, LuckyChap's film *Boston Strangler*, starring Keira Knightley, was released on Hulu.

Also in 2023, LuckyChap's film *Barbie*, directed by Greta Gerwig, starring Margot Robbie and Ryan Gosling, was released by Warner Bros.

Margot Robbie - Producer

Margot Robbie is an Academy Award nominated actress and producer who has captivated global audiences with breakout performances alongside some of the most notable names in film. Continually evolving her diverse body of work, Robbie brings gripping narratives to life in coveted roles that speak to her powerful on-screen presence.

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Robbie was most recently seen in *Barbie* starring as the titular role for Mattel and Warner Bros., alongside Ryan Gosling, American Ferrera, Will Ferrell, and Kate McKinnon, to name a few. Robbie is producing the film under her LuckyChap Entertainment banner. Greta Gerwig and Noah Baumbach co-wrote the screenplay. WB will released the film on July 21, 2023.

Most recently, Robbie starred in Damien Chazelle's 1920s Hollywood drama, *Babylon*, alongside Brad Pitt. Paramount released the film on December 23, 2022. Robbie received a Golden Globe nomination for her performance and the cast received a SAG nomination for Best Ensemble.

Robbie also recently starred in David O. Russell's film *Amsterdam*, alongside Robert De Niro, Christian Bale, and John David Washington. Disney released the film on October 7, 2022.

In August 2021, Robbie reprised her role as the fan-favorite 'Harley Quinn' in *The Suicide Squad*, the sequel to *Suicide Squad*. Directed by James Gunn and co-starring Idris Elba, John Cena and Viola Davis, WB released the film on August 6, 2021. Robbie originated the role in David Ayer's *Suicide Squad*, alongside Will Smith and Jared Leto, which was released on July 1, 2016, and grossed more than \$745M worldwide. In 2020, Robbie played 'Harley Quinn' in the spin-off, *Birds of Prey (And the Fantabulous Emancipation of One Harley Quinn)*. Co-starring Ewan McGregor and Jurnee Smollett, the film, which Robbie also produced, was released by Warner Bros. on February 7, 2020.

In 2019, Robbie starred in Lionsgate's *Bombshell*, alongside Charlize Theron and Nicole Kidman, which was directed by Jay Roach and written by Charles Randolph. Robbie's performance as fictional character 'Kayla Pospisil' earned her a 2020 Academy Award nomination, a 2020 Golden Globe nomination, and a 2020 BAFTA nomination. That same year, Robbie starred in Quentin Tarantino's Academy Award nominated film *Once Upon a Time in Hollywood*, opposite Brad Pitt and Leonardo DiCaprio. The film made its world premiere at the 2019 Cannes Film Festival where it received rave reviews and was nominated for the Palme d'Or. The film later went on to win a Golden Globe Award for Best Motion Picture – Musical or Comedy. Robbie was also recognized for her performance as 'Sharon Tate' with a BAFTA nomination.

In 2018, Robbie starred in Josie Rourke's *Mary Queen of Scots* for Focus Features. She played Queen Elizabeth opposite Saoirse Ronan. Robbie received SAG and BAFTA nominations for her performance.

Most notably, Robbie starred as Tonya Harding in *I, Tonya*. Robbie also served as a producer on the film under her production banner, LuckyChap Entertainment. She received an Academy Award nomination, a Golden Globe nomination, a BAFTA

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nomination, and a SAG nomination for her performance. The film tells the controversial story of Olympic figure skater, Tonya Harding, who infamously conspired to have her competition, Nancy Kerrigan, injured before the 1994 Winter Olympics. The film premiered at the 2017 Toronto International Film Festival and was released by Neon on December 8, 2017.

Robbie's breakout role came in 2013 in Martin Scorsese's *The Wolf of Wall Street*. She stars as the female lead opposite Leonardo DiCaprio. Based on the memoir of the same name by Jordan Belfort, the film tells the story of a New York penny stockbroker (DiCaprio).

Additional film credits include: *Dreamland*; *Terminal*; Sony's *Peter Rabbit 2: The Runaway*, Sony's *Peter Rabbit*, FOX's *Goodbye Christopher Robin*; Paramount's *Whiskey Tango Foxtrot* opposite Tina Fey; *Roadside Attraction's Z for Zachariah* opposite Chris Pine; Warner Bros' *Focus*, opposite Will Smith; Warner Bros' *The Legend of Tarzan*, *Suite Française* alongside Michelle Williams, Kristen Scott Thomas and Matthias Schoenaerts; and *About Time* opposite Rachel McAdams and Domhnall Gleeson.

On television, Robbie made her U.S. debut in the critically acclaimed ABC series, *Pan Am*, in 2011. In Australia, Robbie is most recognized for her role as "Donna Freedman" on the television soap opera *Neighbours*. Her role garnered her two Logie Award nominations for Most Popular New Female Talent and Most Popular Actress.

Robbie has numerous film and television development projects under her LuckyChap Entertainment banner, all of which correspond to her objective of telling stories with strong female characters. LuckyChap recently partnered with Hodson Exports to launch the Lucky Exports Pitch Program (LEPP), an initiative that has selected six female-identifying writers to participate in the program, in which they will each focus on developing their own idea for an original action feature film.

In addition to her work in front-of and behind the camera, Robbie has been a CHANEL ambassador since March 2018.

Born in Australia, Robbie grew up on the Gold Coast and eventually moved to Melbourne where she began acting professionally at the age of 17. She currently resides in Los Angeles.
