The following items are purchased from French Toast.

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PE Standards: K3-K are not required to meet PE uniform standards; however, certain activities may require a pair of sneakers and athletic apparel. Boys may wear Bermuda Style shorts (Classic Navy) for 1st and 4th Quarter with Black Trouser Socks to accommodate for warmer weather.

- **Policy:** Note on Outerwear in the classroom: Outerwear is not allowed in the classroom unless it is approved uniform outerwear (ie: Navy Sweater or ACA printed Hoodie), Any color, other than navy, is not permitted.

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PE Standards: Students, grades 2nd and above, must dress out in ACA P.E. T-Shirt and Shorts and sneakers. These are available for purchase through ACA. Certain activities will require sneakers i.e. Field Trips, Field Day. Boys through 1st grade may wear Bermuda Style shorts (Classic Navy) for 1st and 4th Quarter with Black Trouser Socks to accommodate for warmer weather.

Dialectic School Uniforms

(effective 08/01/16)

5th through 8th grade (Girls)

5th through 8th grade (Boys)

All Dialectic students are required to have at least one (1) Gold Logo Polo shirt for Polo Uniform & one (1) Navy Logo V-Neck Vest which are exclusive to French Toast.

Polo Uniform (Fridays/as designated)

- Gold Logo Polo (short/long sleeve) (may be worn with uniform standards or Navy Dress Slacks as earned and designated by Administration.
- Navy Dress Uniform Slacks for non-best dress days only.

Best Dressed Uniform (standard)

- Button-up Peter Pan Collar Blouse (White)
- Plaid Pleated Skirt (Blue/Gold)
- Navy Logo Sweater Vest
- “Biker Shorts” / Bloomers, (Navy or Black) (to be worn under the Pleated Skirt at all times, no other colors permitted.)
- White socks or white tights
- Black Mary Jane Shoes, Flats or quarter pump
- **Option:** Winter tights of navy or white (no leggings). Button-down Cardigan Sweater (Navy)
- **Note on Modesty:** Skirts should fall just above or at the knee, slacks should be modest fitting uniform pants (no spandex, skinny, or tight fitting pants). No exposed or visible undergarments including camisoles. Camisoles should be white.

Consequence: *Students wearing clothing not within standards and/or deemed inappropriate will result in the student being removed from the classroom until an approved standard is obtained.* Letter detailing infractions will be sent for repeat offenders.

- NO denim or cargo pants.
- Blouses must be free from wrinkles and remain properly tucked at all times.
- Heels, open toe shoes, and boot ARE NOT permissible.

Polo Uniform (Fridays/as designated)

- Gold Logo Polo (short/long sleeve) (may be worn with uniform standards or Navy Slacks as earned and designated by Administration.

Best Dressed Uniform (standard)

- Button-down Oxford Shirt, white or oxford blue (short/long sleeve). Dress Uniform Slacks (Classic Navy)
- Navy Logo Sweater Vest
- Plaid Neck Tie (Blue/Gold) (No clip, Velcro, or zipper ties will be permitted for this age group.)
- Black crew/dress socks
- Black Dress Shoes (must be polishable)
- Black Belt

Rhetoric students are required to have at least one (1) Gold Logo Polo shirt for Polo Uniform (exclusive to French Toast) & one (1) Blazer w/Crest. Crest is purchased through ACA.

Polo Uniform (Fridays/as designated)

- Gold Logo Polo (short/long sleeve) (may be worn with uniform standards or Navy Dress Slacks as earned and designated by Administration.
- Navy or Khaki Dress Uniform Slacks for non-best dressed days.

Best Dressed Uniform (standard)

- Navy Dress Blazer with Logo
- Button-down Oxford Blouse (white, blue, yellow short/long sleeve)
- A-Line or Kick Pleat Skirt (Classic Navy)
- “Biker Shorts” / Bloomers, (Navy or Black) (to be worn under the Pleated Skirt at all times, no other colors permitted.)
- Skin-toned hose preferred (no designated vendor)
- Black Mary Jane Shoes, Flats, or 1” heel pump.
- **Option:** Winter tights of navy or white (no leggings). Button-down Cardigan Sweater (Navy). Rhetoric girls may wear the Navy/Gold striped tie.
- **Note on Modesty:** Skirts should fall just above or at the knee, slacks should be modest fitting uniform pants (no spandex, skinny, or tight fitting pants). No exposed or visible undergarments including camisoles. Camisoles/undergarments should be white under blouses.

Consequence: Any uniform standards deemed inappropriate will result in the student being removed from the classroom until an approved uniform is obtained. Letter detailing infractions will be sent for repeat offenders.

- NO denim or cargo pants
- Blouses must be free from wrinkles and properly tucked at all times.
- NO hosiery with lace, flowers or other designs.
- Heels, open-toed shoes, and boots ARE NOT permitted.

Polo Uniform (Fridays/as designated)

- Gold Logo Polo (short/long sleeve) (may be worn with uniform standards to include Navy or Khaki Slacks as earned and designated by Administration.

Best Dressed Uniform (standard)

- Navy Dress Blazer with Logo
- Button-down Oxford Shirt, white, oxford blue, and/or oxford yellow (short/long sleeve).
- Dress Uniform Slacks (Classic Navy)
- Navy/Gold striped Neck Tie (No clip, Velcro, or zipper ties will be permitted for this age group.)
- Black crew/dress socks
- Black Dress Shoes (must be polishable)
- Black Belt
- **Note on Modesty:** No exposed or visible undergarments including undershirts or T-shirts. Undershirts or T-shirts should be white.
- **Consequence:** Any uniform standards deemed inappropriate will result in the student being removed from the classroom until an approved uniform is obtained. Letter detailing infractions will be sent for repeat offenders.
