Trip Overview

How does the agenda fulfill our goals of exploration, education, and empowerment?

The students will get a variety of opportunities to “explore” in many senses of the word. Their first activity will be meeting Outdoor Program staff who can talk to them about exploring the outdoors safely and in ways that some of them might never have considered yet. Students will explore the Outdoor Program barn, which is full of gear meant to get anyone and everyone outside to enjoy what Oregon has to offer. Next, the students will tour Autzen Stadium, exploring an emblem of Oregon while also exploring the possibility that one of them might one day wear the Ducks uniform. These two opportunities on the UO campus will hopefully also empower the students to think about their dreams in education and where dedication to those goals could take them.

The final activity for the day is a trip to Mt. Pisgah Arboretum in order to participate in the Play in the Rain Day. About a dozen organizations have partnered to create this free, day-long event for families to explore the natural world and learn about their local habitats. Students will have the chance to participate in the following: tree climbing, campfire cookery, archery, nature exploration, hikes, nature crafts, backcountry horse demos, hayrides, scavenger hunts, and meeting Smokey the Bear. All of these activities have the potential to inspire and empower students.
