Ilana Panich-Linsman (b. 1984) is a visual journalist based in Austin, Texas. Her regular clients include *The New York Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Washington Post*, Audubon Magazine, Rolling Stone, ESPN, and more.

In 2014, she was named one Magnum Photo's 30 under 30. Her work has been recognized by the Lucie Foundation; the Oso Bay Biennial XVIII; Slideluck Potshow, Austin; and the Lumix Festival in Hannover, Germany. Her work appeared in the AI-AP American Photo 30 and Fotografia Magazine. Her work has been showcased on The New York Times LENS blog and on the CNN photography blog .

Other awards and honors include the Multimedia Award at the 2010 Lumix Festival for Young Photojournalism; she was nominated for the World Press Photo Joop Swart Masterclass in the same year. Ilana participated in the VII Mentorship Program.
