The courses provide in-depth discussions of leadership theory, competencies and best practices led by tribal leaders and leadership experts.

Founded in October 2015 by Mr. Littlepage, Tribal Diagnostics works as a premiere high complexity diagnostics laboratory located in Oklahoma that supports all health care providers with a focus on tribal and rural communities. With over 15 years of experience in the health care field, Mr. Littlepage is aware of the vast health care disparities in Indian Country. He is also a [2017 recipient](#) of the National Center for American Indian Enterprise Development's (NCAIED) prestigious "40 Under 40" award.

Prior to starting Tribal Diagnostics, Mr. Littlepage worked for a private equity portfolio company, Expert Global Solutions (EGS), performing merger integration work. Due to his performance, he was promoted to lead EGS' largest health care account, effectively coordinating the efforts of 2,400 EGS colleagues across 10 international locations. Mr. Littlepage has a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from the University of Kansas and a MBA in Finance from Southern Methodist University.
