WHO WE ARE

Boston Chinatown Neighborhood Center (BCNC) responds to community needs by delivering holistic, family-centered, and culturally competent programs. Founded in 1969, BCNC is the largest nonprofit social service provider for Asian American and Asian immigrant families in the Greater Boston Area, supporting over 2,000 children, youth, and adults each year at three locations in Boston and Quincy.

OUR MISSION

The mission of BCNC is to ensure that the children, youth, and families we serve have the resources and supports they need to achieve greater economic success and social well-being.

OUR PROGRAMS

BCNC provides families **Access, Opportunity, and Community** through the following programs:

- **Child Care & Enrichment Programs:** BCNC supports working families through dual-language child care, as well as enriching and culturally competent after school and summer programs. Programs include: Acorn Center for Early Education and Care, Family Child Care, Red Oak After School & Summer, and Recreation & Fitness.
- **Education & Workforce Initiatives:** BCNC supports youth and adults to identify and follow an education or career pathway that leads to higher education, a stable career, and financial stability. Programs include: Adult Education and Youth Center.
- **Family & Community Engagement:** BCNC's family-centered service model recognizes that effective organizations do not merely serve participants in individual programs. BCNC Family Services serve participants knowing they are part of a larger family through parent education, parent support groups and case management.

Our Vision

BCNC believes that families have enormous potential to thrive, and that when immigrants are able to participate fully in society and create their own success stories, all of society benefits.



BCNC's vision is that:

- *Families and individuals are self-sufficient;*
- *Families are strong, healthy, and safe;*
- *Children have opportunities for school success; and*
- *Neighborhoods are strong and cohesive.*



OUR VISION IS THAT:

*Families and individuals
are self-sufficient.*

- 255 individuals participated in financial literacy workshops.
- 245 adults participated in English language classes to further their education or career.
- 100% of high school seniors were accepted to 4 year colleges with financial aid.



When Xianwen “Jeff” Li came to the US in 2013, he was initially excited about the new sights and sounds. Before long, though, Jeff started feeling lonely and regretful. He came from a comfortable life with a well-paying job, however in Boston he found he couldn’t speak English well enough to buy what he needed at the store. Jeff accepted a job as a waiter in a Chinese restaurant, but it embarrassed him when he could not understand customers. He came to BCNC and began a journey to success that continues today. BCNC provided a platform for Jeff to improve his conversational and writing skills. One teacher, Taylor Liss, encouraged him to read newspapers without using a dictionary. Another teacher, Kim Lampereur, helped him write an essay. Jeff was able to successfully move on to the Bridges to College program and is currently completing a certificate program in Biotechnology.

OUR VISION IS THAT:

Families are strong, healthy, and safe.

- **436 people participated in parent support programs including parent leadership training, support groups, workshops, playgroups and field trips.**
- **Families who participate in Family Services are able to:**
 - actively cope with challenges and remain positive;
 - actively apply for all available public benefits; and
 - better understand child development.



Chun Hua initially came to BCNC to learn English and find a good job. However, when her son was diagnosed with autism, BCNC Family Services became a valuable resource for her. Chun was concerned with her child's social interactions, language skills, and behavioral issues. Through monthly parent meetings and meetings with a child development specialist, BCNC enabled Chun to learn about her child's development and connect with parents facing similar experiences. BCNC helped Chun access services that taught her how to support her son's social-emotional and language growth. Chun warmly recalled taking her son to Special Art, a collaboration between BCNC and the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston. "I didn't want to take him," she says. She worried he would run around the room and not want to sit or draw. But he surprised her. "My son really focused and sat for a long time. It was great!" Chun saw her child's progress which made her extremely happy and thankful for the services she received.

OUR VISION IS THAT:

Children have opportunities for school success.

- **100% of children who entered kindergarten from BCNC's Acorn Center for Early Education and Care met or exceeded developmental standards in all areas: motor skills, language, literacy, and math.**
- **After participating in BCNC's Red Oak After School program, children who completed their homework most or all of the time increased from 52% to 87%.**
- **176 youth participated in youth leadership programs, where they gained 21st century skills needed to succeed in college and career.**

Amy Cheung is a doctoral student at Harvard's Graduate School for Education who volunteers with the BCNC Youth Center as a mentor. Although she has worked with groups of youth before, Amy found the responsibility of serving as a mentor more "intimate" and "intense." She felt a different sense of responsibility that made the stakes seem higher.

Through the eyes of her mentee, Amy began to see how difficult it can be to navigate the college process as an English Language Learner: "I remember going on a college tour with her and suddenly realizing how difficult it would be for my mentee to understand all of the information being thrown at her. Even though there were programs for diverse groups, they're not actually that accessible for English language learners. It was a transformative experience that gave me a newfound appreciation for the range of challenges a more recent immigrant student might encounter."

Amy's mentee is now in college and continues to learn and grow. The same is true for Amy, as she continues to mentor young people.

- **88% of parents of preschoolers reported BCNC helps them learn about community resources.**
- **BCNC registered 182 new voters and distributed 3,000 voter outreach materials.**

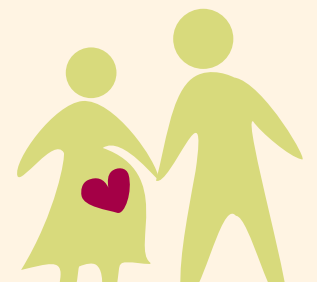


I really liked the program when I was young, and the way that we all seemed like family here. I knew my kids would be in good hands.

Sheila Wong remembers her experience as a child in BCNC's Acorn Center for Early Education and Care as a time where she had ample space for dramatic and pretend play, and she was cared for by her teachers. Sheila's involvement with BCNC continued after preschool - she worked in the Recreation program and then was one of the first Youth Center staff when it opened in the 1990s.

Now Sheila has a family of her own. She considered the BCNC community a "second family," so the decision to enroll her own children in BCNC's childcare center was easy, especially given the sense of connection to BCNC she developed. Sheila explains: "I searched a lot of childcare programs, even around the Chinatown neighborhood, and everything led me back to BCNC. I really liked the program when I was young, and the way that we all seemed like family here. I knew my kids would be in good hands."

As a parent, Sheila has been able to witness her own children experience the same warmth and care she did when she was young. "I love it that the teachers are so caring. It's reassuring for a parent to see that the teachers care for them almost as if they were their own kids." BCNC continues to impact families across generations, like Sheila's, in the community.

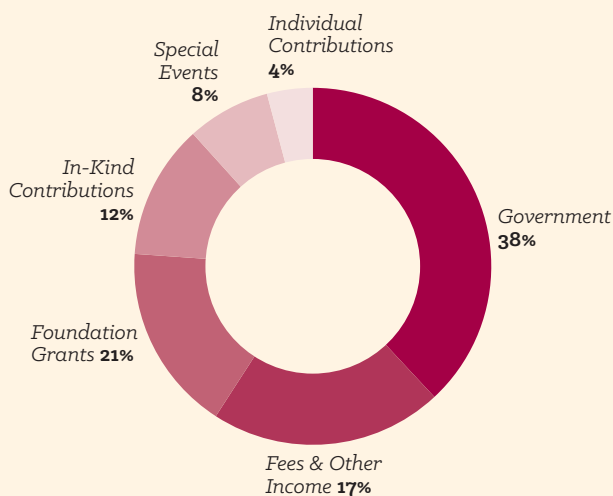

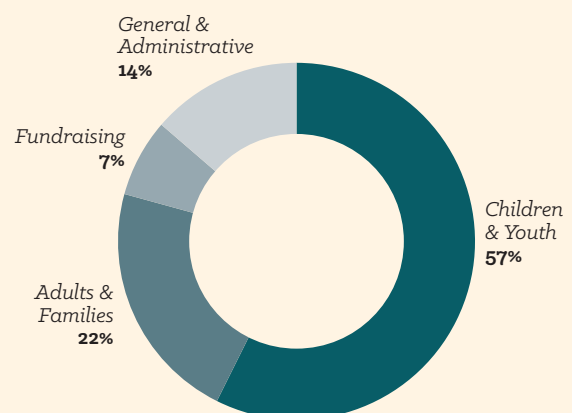
