ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility for The Story Prize is restricted to printed collections of short fiction (at least two stories and/or novellas) by a living author, written in English. Eligible works must be first print publication of the work in the U.S. during the calendar year, in either hardcover or paperback, and available for purchase by the general public, with an ISBN number. Collections must include at least some work previously unpublished in book form.

Books published from January through June must be submitted by July 15.

Books published from July through December must be submitted by Nov. 15.

Both copies can be e-books if conditions resulting from the coronavirus pandemic make it impossible to mail printed books, but we would prefer at least one printed copy. Standalone e-books are not eligible. If finished copies of books scheduled to be published in December are not available, bound galleys or ARCs are acceptable.
