- Founded in 1983, the Noyes Museum of Art of Stockton University is the only art museum serving the eight southernmost counties of New Jersey.
- A registered 501(c) 3 non-profit organization, the mission of the museum is to provide the southern New Jersey region and its visitors with an opportunity to learn about, explore and experience the arts.
- The museum has a collection of American contemporary fine art, traditional and contemporary folk art and crafts numbering approximately 1,800 objects — paintings, prints, photographs and sculptural works.
- With locations in Atlantic City, Galloway Township and Hammonton, the museum's galleries are also conveniently accessible to audiences in New York, Philadelphia and Baltimore.
- With over 500 members and 12,000 square feet of exhibition space, the Noyes draws visitors nationwide.

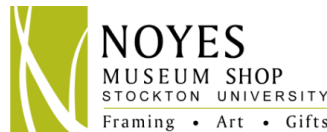

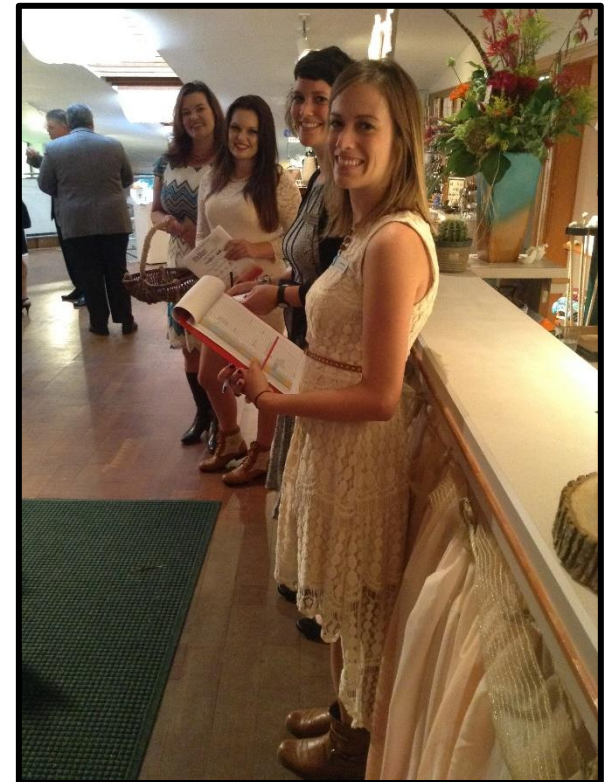

**Volunteer Program**

- **Education:** Individuals with a background or interest in education and art can help facilitate adult's and children's classes, workshops, hands-on art activities and other programs.
- **Docent:** After attending docent training sessions, lead tours of current exhibitions for school, community and civic groups (tours scheduled by appointment).
- **Exhibitions and Collections:** Volunteers with a background in the arts and exhibitions can assist, after training, with seasonal installations, from spackling and painting walls to mounting and placing artwork.
- **Outreach:** Assist with offsite events and community art activities. Distribute materials, manage information booths and promote our various satellite galleries.

- **Front Desk:** Help make our guests' first impression of the museum a positive one. Greet visitors and provide information regarding the museum, exhibitions and various programs. Visitor services volunteers may also answer the phone, collect admission fees and sell items from our shop.
- **Events:** Assist with various aspects of event preparation such as set-up, clean-up, refreshments and guest registration at our opening receptions, annual gala, jazz concerts, poetry readings and other enriching programs and events.
- **Social Media:** Assist in computer and website maintenance or fuel your creative outlet through opportunities in video/film and photography.
- **Office Assistance:** Help with answering phone, mailings, filing, copying, data entry and other special projects.
