What is The Noyes Arts Garage of Stockton University?

The Noyes Arts Garage Stockton University is the cornerstone of the new Arts District in Atlantic City with a mission to promote education, provide resources for emerging artists, and enrich the community. The Arts Garage houses artist studios, galleries, shops, a café, a flexible classroom studio, and hosts special events throughout the year. It includes a 1,200 square foot gallery of The Noyes Museum of Art and the African American Heritage Museum of Southern New Jersey.

What is an artist inquiry?

The Noyes Arts Garage of Stockton University is interested in learning more about you and your work to establish possible new exhibition opportunities. These exhibition opportunities exist in the Osprey Gallery at the Noyes Arts Garage of Stockton University at 2200 Fairmount Avenue, Atlantic City, NJ 08401.

What are the criteria for an inquiry application?

The Noyes Arts Garage of Stockton University is looking for high-quality work in diverse media with an original and personal viewpoint. The application must be filled out in its entirety. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

REQUIREMENTS:

Artist Inquiry Applications will be evaluated by a committee based upon a review of the work and the application (with supporting documentation.)

1. General information - Provide the following:

- **Artist Statement:** A one page description of the body of work being presented. This may include a description of the creative process/inspiration, underlying themes and message, to give the reviewers an understanding of the work presented.
- **Artist Biography:** Can act as an artist resume.
- **Complete Contact Information:** Including mailing address, email, website and social media if applicable (General Info Form provided)
- **Average Price Point:** What is the average price of your work?

2. Visual material: Supply 10-20 digital images of work, at least 300 dpi

- **Email:** Attach images of work with artist name, titles, dimensions, and medium
- **Mail:** CD with images of work with artist name, titles, dimensions, and medium (no slides or printed photos)
- **Support material:** If available, include catalogues and printed photographs. They are accepted ONLY as support material.

3. List Museum/Gallery Representation:

If available, provide list of gallery and museum representation. Include dates and sample press from the exhibition(s).
