2018-2019 Statement of Tuition, Fees and Payment Plans

Welcome!

We are excited about your interest in enrolling for the 2018-2019 school year at GCA. We honor the fact that Christian education is a commitment and we hope to make the decision as easy as possible.

As you prepare for next year, a variety of options will be available to you. We have several information sessions planned, during which we will share information on the following:

We will also be able to schedule a time for one-on-one meetings to sit down with your family and guide you through the process if you have specific questions. Dates for these sessions will be posted in the near future. We will share those dates on social media and in the GCA newsletter. If you have questions in the meantime, use the GCA website to fill out our interactive questionnaire, so our enrollment team can get back to you as quickly as possible! We look forward to speaking with you soon.

As you look over the basic information for tuition and fees below, keep in mind these numbers do not reflect the many avenues available for families, including potential scholarships and aid.

Please know that spots fill up quickly, therefore it is very important that you return your paperwork promptly, with the appropriate fees, so we can reserve your spot.

Enrollment Fees

The enrollment fee is \$200.00 per student (\$150.00 for K4 and ½ day K5) and must be submitted with the completed enrollment form. This fee is nonrefundable. No student application will be processed unless the enrollment fee is attached and all outstanding balances are resolved.

Financial Transaction Processing

Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, all financial transactions shall be processed through the FACTS Tuition Management system. Tuition, fees and invoiced services for before and after school supervision, bus transport, extracurricular activities, etc. will be billed and collected through this system. GCA can, if necessary, assist families in establishing accounts and choosing automated payment options via that system.

If a credit card is used, an additional processing fee of 2.85% will be added.

This fee is due June 30, 2018. It is non refundable.

Late fee

A \$30 late fee will be assessed if a scheduled payment is not received on its due date.

International Students

International students will pay \$9,709.95 in tuition plus additional admin fees for tutoring, housing, and more. For more information please contact ckresge@gcak12.org.

Refunds and Partial Year Enrollees

Refunds or payments will be calculated based on the month that the student in good standing is enrolled or withdrawn. No partial month calculations will be made.

Family Financial Assistance (grades K-12)

Families may be eligible for tuition assistance by application for:

- Indiana School Choice Scholarships
- Indiana SGO Scholarships

Additional need-based assistance from GCA may be received based on recommendations by FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment (*may be limited by available funds*).

Christian Ministry Scholarships (grades K-12)

Students of full-time Christian pastors and missionaries may receive tuition assistance through:

- Eligibility for Indiana School Choice Scholarships by application
- Eligibility for Indiana SGO Scholarships by application

Additional assistance may be received from GCA for up to 25% of tuition, depending on amount of State-funded sources available.

Christian Education Commitment Scholarships (grades K-12)

Families otherwise not eligible for tuition assistance may apply for Christian Education Commitment Scholarships for enrolling multiple students in GCA. For each additional child that attends GCA, you are eligible for the following amounts:

2 nd student	\$600.00
3 rd student	\$750.00
4 th + students	\$900.00 each
