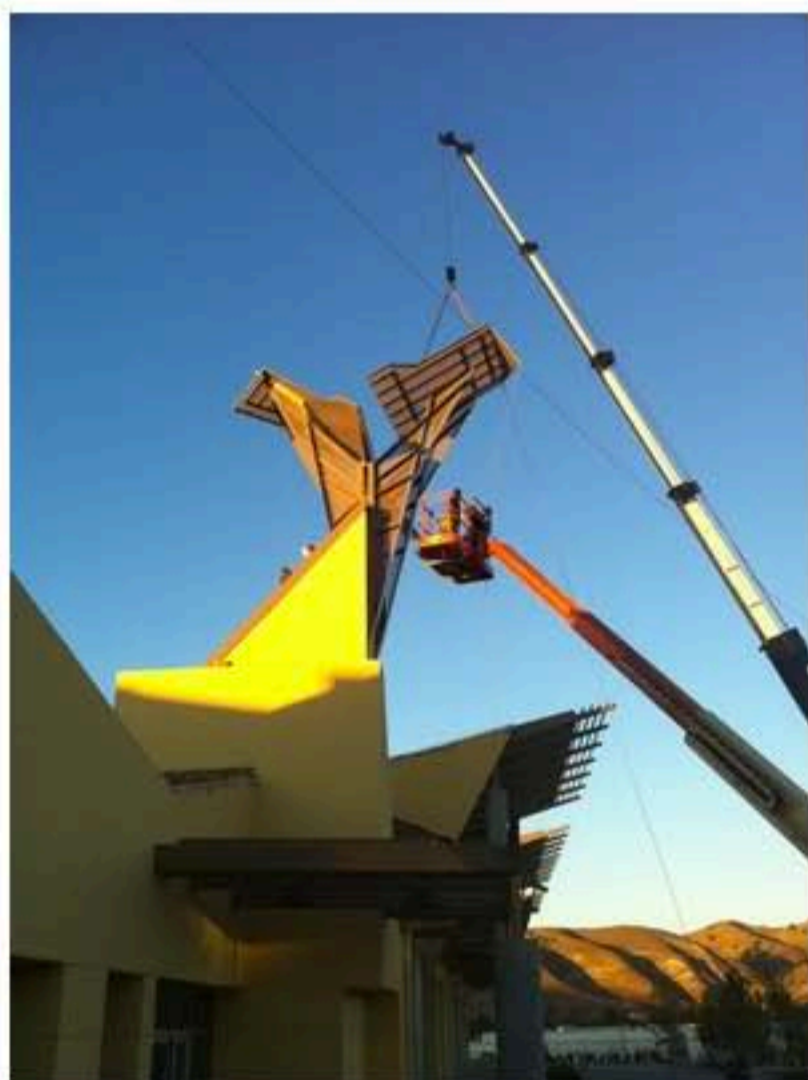

Behr Browers Architects Inc. recently received an Architectural Design Honor Award from the American Institute of Architects, Ventura Chapter, for the design of the Summit Retail Project in Calabasas, California. The Summit was the first private commercial development to be required to achieve LEED Silver equivalent standards by the City of Calabasas. The project's distinctive design reflects its mission of incorporating and integrating numerous energy and resource conservation strategies in order to reduce the development's carbon footprint. It was the only commercial project of the 4 recognized with this level of award.

Jason Oliver LEED AP BD+C, the Project Architect and Francisco Behr AIA, the Design Director and Partner, attended the awards Ceremony held at the Spanish Hills Country Club in December of 2011.

Led by Michael Browers AIA, Francisco Behr AIA and Andrew Althaus AIA, Behr Browers Architects Inc. has been responsible for some of the largest planning and architecture projects in the area and have received numerous local and national Awards over the last 30 years of engaging in Architecture.
