UNB Student Union reaches \$4,800 for Shinerama Fundraiser

Fredericton, NB – - Since 1973, the University of New Brunswick Student Union (UNBSU) has participated in Shinerama. Shinerama is one of Canada's largest post-secondary fundraising campaigns and raises money for Cystic Fibrosis Canada. Over the past 42 years through Shine Day, Orientation Week, and summer fundraisers, the UNBSU has raised over \$600,000 for the cause.

The 2016 Shinerama Chair, Katie Bonner is inspired to see how well fundraising is going. "This summer has already been so rewarding, and Shine Day has not even happened yet." said Katie. "Each week we're moving closer and closer to surpassing our \$25,000 goal, so far we have raised over \$4,800."

The UNBSU has organized a variety of events to raise money for Shinerama, this summer alone the UNBSU has held 11 Trivia Nights, a Goji's Fundraiser and spent Canada Day in Officer's Square collecting donations. In addition to these events, Bonner has planned a car wash this Saturday, August 6th from 11am to 4pm at Dana's Collision Centre (369 St. Mary's Street). All funds raised from these events go to directly support Shinerama.
