

#### **OVERVIEW**

- Survey was open from May 16 through August 8, 2016
- 1,425 people responded to the survey
- Key Findings
  - Fixing the existing system is most important to survey respondents
  - Rapid Transit is where respondents would invest the largest share of funding
  - Making service more reliable is the top priority for improving existing services
  - New or extended Rapid Transit is the highest priority for providing new MBTA access for areas that are not currently served


# **USING MBTA SERVICES**

#### Which services do you use at least once a week?





#### How would you allocate funding to increase capacity by mode?




# **INCREASING BUS CAPACITY**

If you had 20 points to spend on increasing bus capacity, how would you allocate these points?




#### **INCREASING RAPID TRANSIT CAPACITY**
