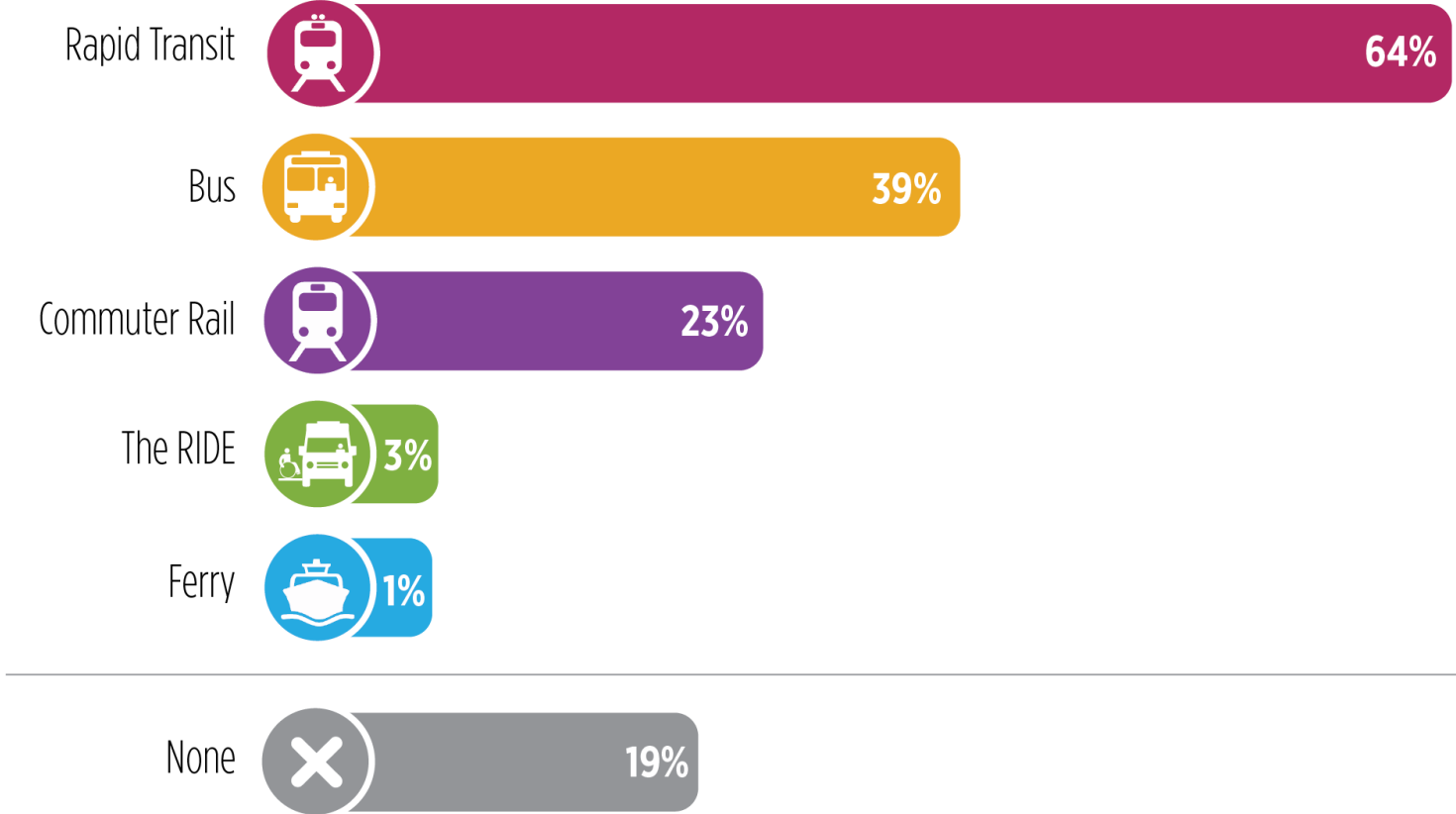

OVERVIEW

- Survey was open from May 16 through August 8, 2016
- 1,425 people responded to the survey
- Key Findings
 - Fixing the existing system is most important to survey respondents
 - Rapid Transit is where respondents would invest the largest share of funding
 - Making service more reliable is the top priority for improving existing services
 - New or extended Rapid Transit is the highest priority for providing new MBTA access for areas that are not currently served

INVESTMENT PRIORITIES

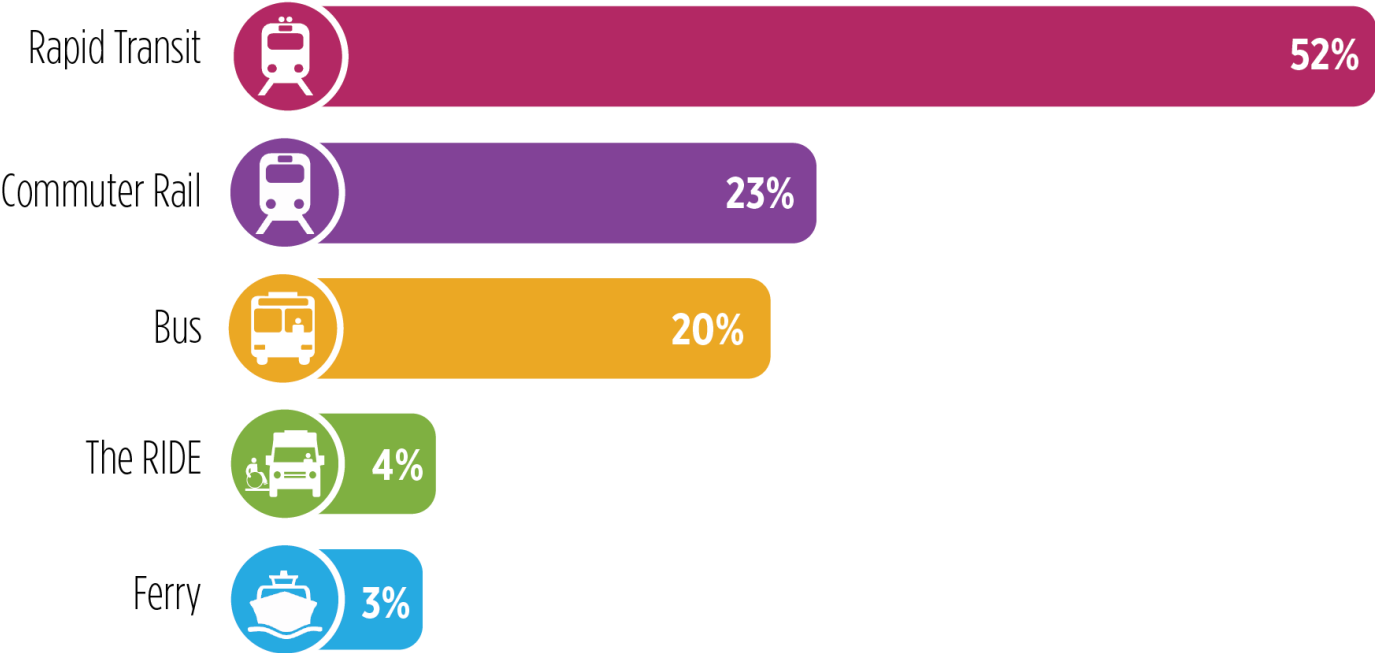
How would you allocate investment among these categories?

INCREASING BUS CAPACITY

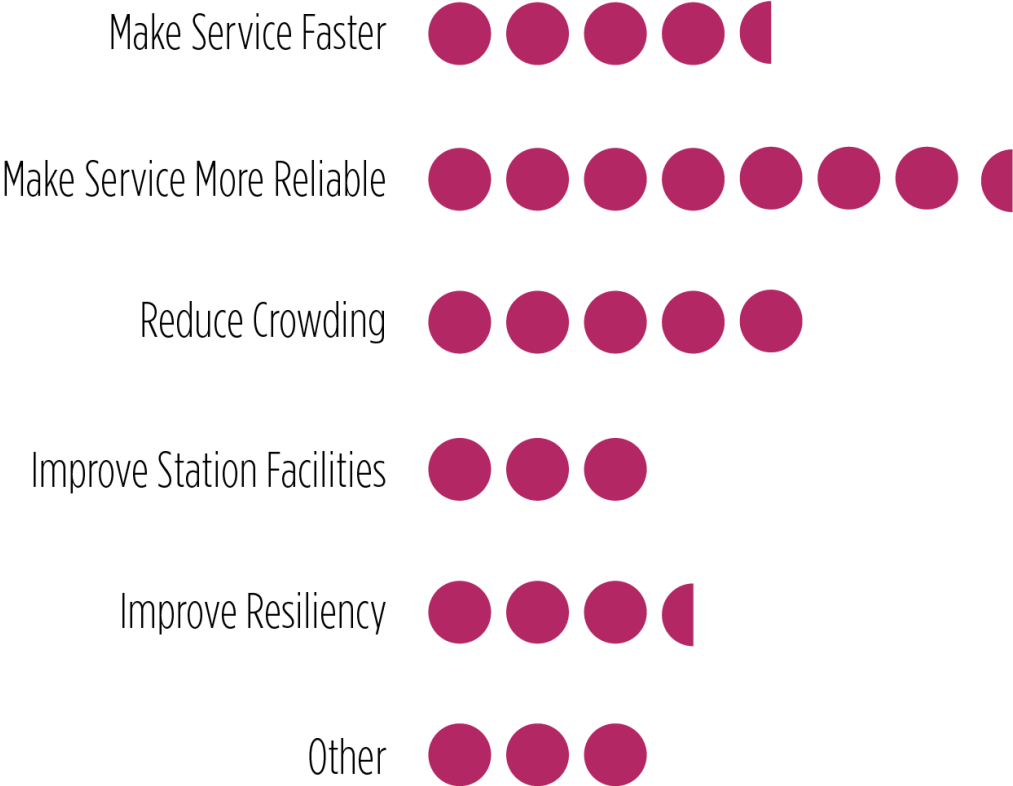
If you had 20 points to spend on increasing bus capacity, how would you allocate these points?

INCREASING RAPID TRANSIT CAPACITY

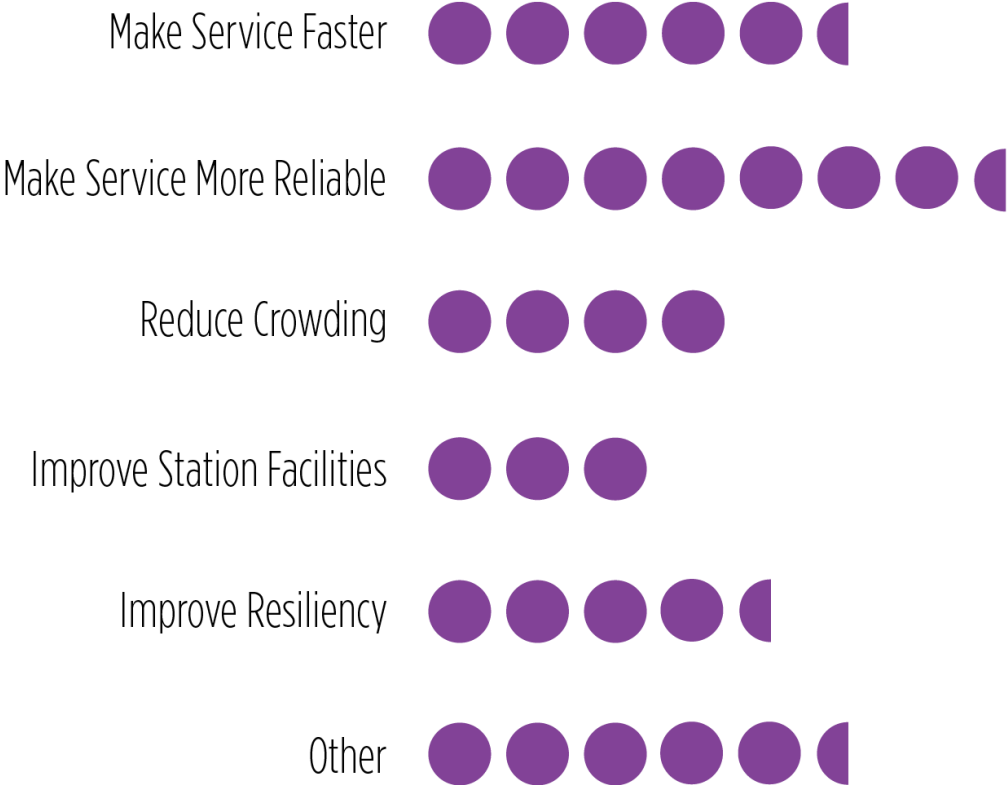
If you had 20 points to spend on increasing rapid transit capacity, how would you allocate these points?
