Private group bookings, corporate tours and options for educational institutions are also available.

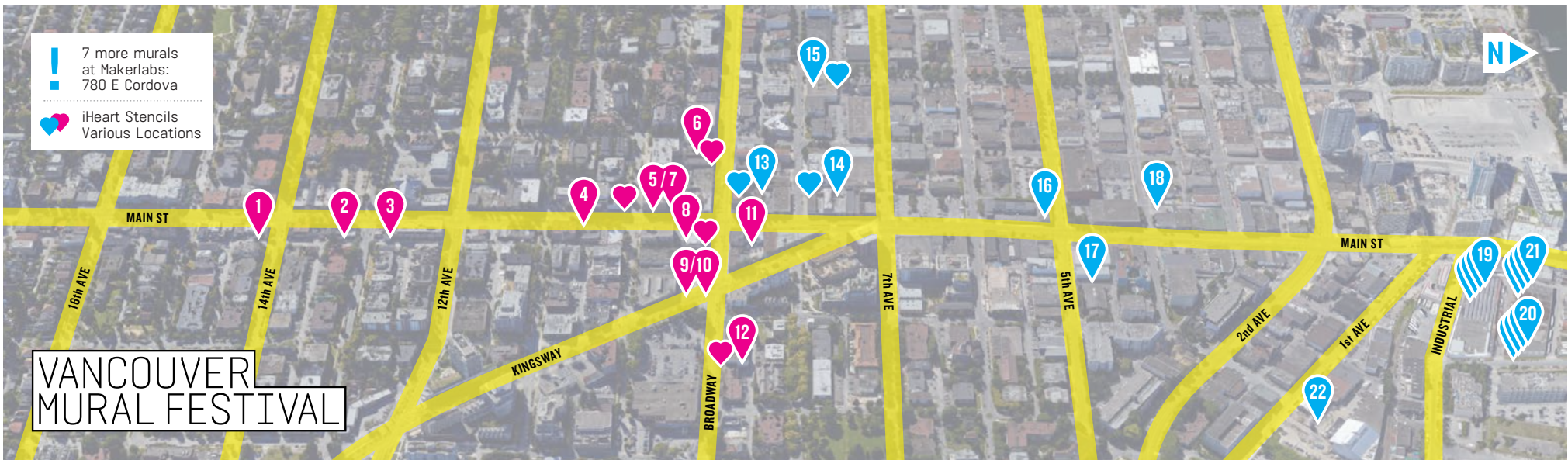
