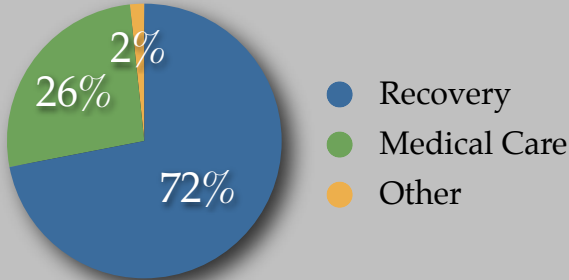

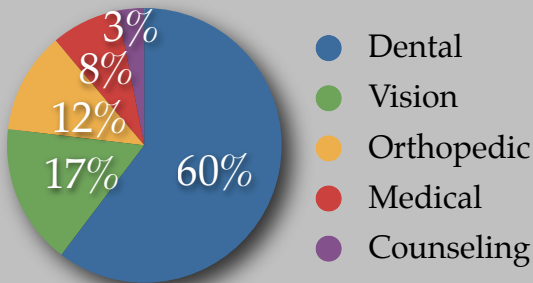

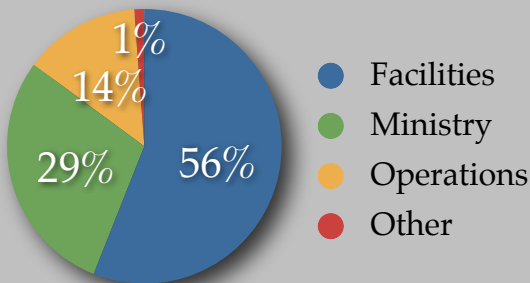
FINANCIAL STATUS: SINCE INCEPTION



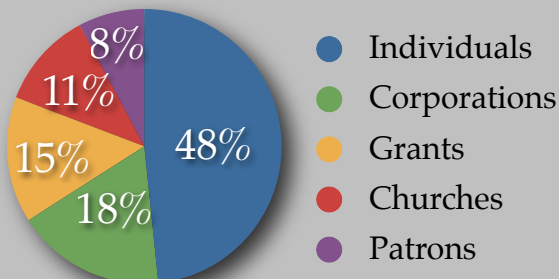
**Total Number of Visits: 14,262**
