May this valuable Biblical principle guide us as we serve the Lord this year!

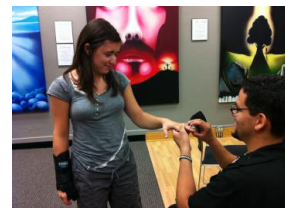
“I know the plans I have for you...”

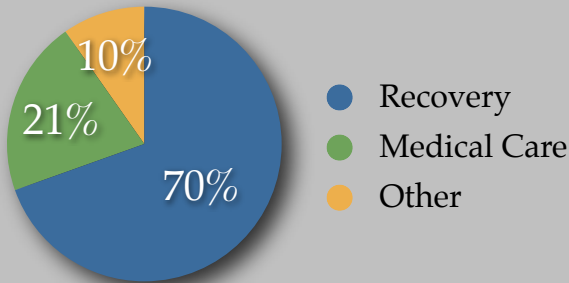

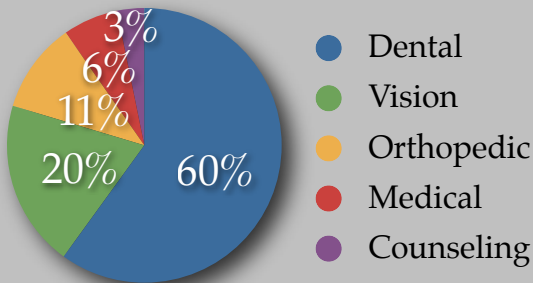

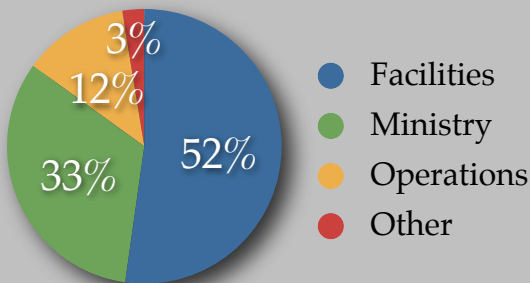
FINANCIAL STATUS: SINCE INCEPTION



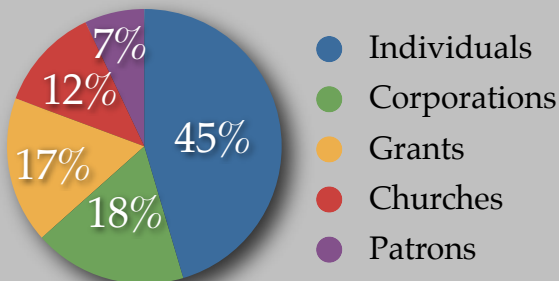
Total Number of Visits: 11,780
