

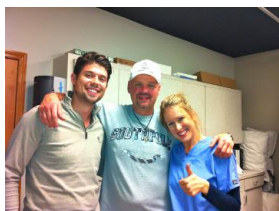

While all of our medical ministries experienced growth, the dental clinic noted an explosive 500% increase as a result of adding the second dental chair. In addition, we also welcomed Dr. Melissa Verhagen who is now offering chiropractic services. More than 95% of the services we offer are **not** covered under the Affordable Healthcare Act.

Volunteer Participation

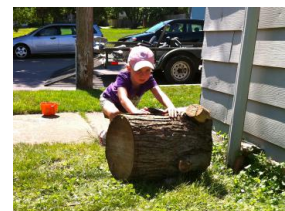

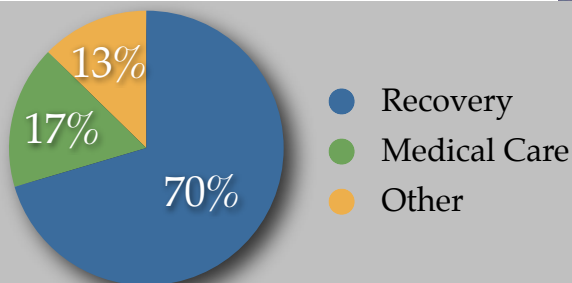

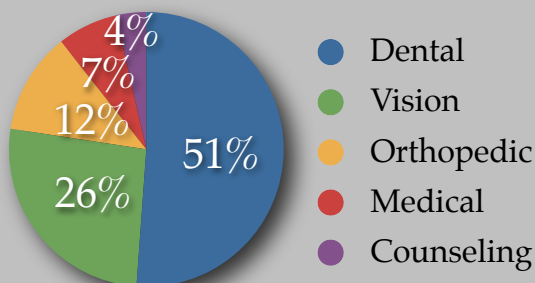

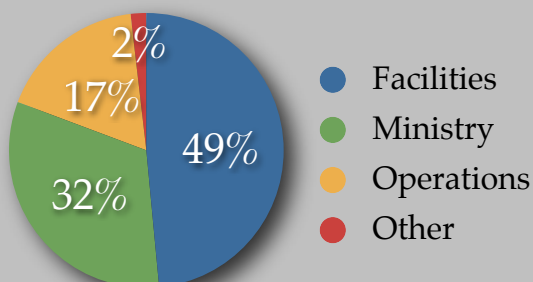
FINANCIAL STATUS: SINCE INCEPTION



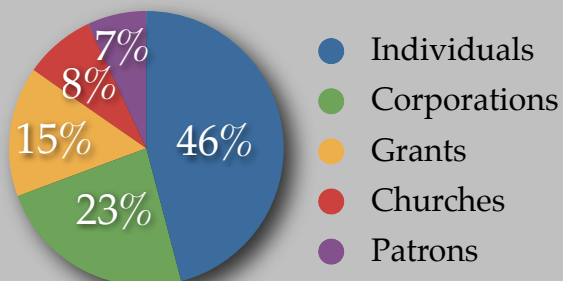
Total Number of Visits: 6968

2013 Snapshot - God's Story at Mission Possible

- *God sustained us for a second year of ministry
- *Bible studies grow to four per week
- *Host of several Fox Valley House of Prayer worship events
- *Community partnerships blossomed with the City of Aurora
- *Community garden launched at 169-171 S. LaSalle Street with volunteer partnership from Redemption Fellowship, Community Christian Church, Christ Community Church, The Edge Church, Harvest Bible Chapel, Ginger Creek, and Community 4:12
- *Dental clinic reaches max capacity in May 2013
- *First day time dental clinics launch in July 2013
- *Donors successfully raise \$10,000 for dental clinic expansion
- *Second dental chair added in August 2013
- *Grants received from Illinois State Dental Society, Walmart, and Andrews Family Foundation
- *Public speaking opportunities: Kiwanis, WYLL and WBIG radio
- *Chiropractic services and haircuts added in November 2013
