
Dental Clinic Expansion

One Year Later: Doubling The Capacity

It's hard to imagine that one year after opening the dental clinic, we would be adding a second dental operator. With roughly 200 patients on the waiting list and a growing number of dental volunteers, it is clearly time for expansion. Nearly as soon as we realized that we were having a dental clinic almost every night of the week, God began providing the necessary elements for growth including another dental chair and several thousand dollars worth of donated supplies. Currently, the only thing that stands in the way of two fully operational chairs is a \$7000 portable delivery unit.
