In rebellion, he pursued a life of drugs, alcohol, gangs, and graffiti. Broken and without hope, Milton was confronted by street ministers and a group of great friends who led him back to Christ. Now, as a graduate of American Academy of Art, he uses his talents to glorify God by "tagging" for Christ, lecturing nationally to youth groups, teaching art classes, and directing a youth ministry called Street Art Ministry in Chicago. As the most important artistic expression of our ministry, Milton Coronado has created six oversized canvasses to share the gospel message with our patrons. Through vibrant colors and creative images, he has captured the important themes of creation (see picture), sin, Calvary, baptism, purification, and heaven. Visible by the street day and night, his work will be on permanent display.
