### New Kiosks Coming Soon



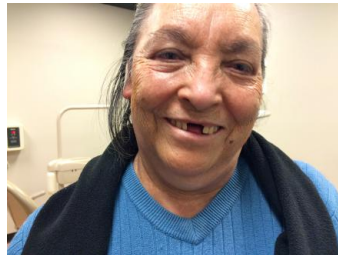

The participants on the recovery side of the ministry will soon benefit from online GED, job search, computer training, Bible research, and resume building programs in addition to a few Christian music listening stations. The medical patrons will have access to an online diabetes education program and Duolingo to help our Spanish speakers learn English. ### Better Care For Our Diabetics



With the help of the Andrew Family Foundation, we have been able to provide more care for our diabetics than we ever imagined. Since the start of the new year, we have been dispensing free glucometers, testing strips, lancets, and medication for those who are unable to afford these expensive supplies. Our hands are no longer tied as we watch blood sugars spiral out of control. No longer are we weeping with the patients who lacked the financial means. Instead, we are praising God for improved health. These resources combined with access to blood labs will bless many people.

### Mission Smiles Launches



As a regular volunteer of our dental clinic, Calli Willet was moved to action by some of our toothless patrons. The many extractions performed by our dental clinic alters smiles and digestion. The burden of this impact continued to build. Finally, with the help of many of Calli's relatives, we figured out a way to pay for material costs of partial and full dentures through the Mission Smiles program. Though we can't provide dentures for the whole world, we can replace a few of the teeth that we have pulled. So far, three patients have been able to take advantage of this amazing opportunity.

God pointed him to Aurora and connected him with Wayside Cross Master's Touch program, Redeemer Church, and Mission Possible.
